

### 23 Candidates In Moncton Election

MONCTON, N. B., April 8—(CP)—Twenty-three candidates will contest the nine seats in Moncton's city council in civic elections to be held next Tuesday, it was announced.

Voters will go to the polls next week to elect a mayor, two aldermen-at-large and two ward aldermen in each of the city's three wards. Elections are held annually.

Mayor F. W. Storey will seek reelection and his only opponent will be T. Babbitt Parlee.

### Vancouver Newspapers Increase Rates

VANCOUVER, April 8—(CP)—The Vancouver Daily Province has announced an increase in subscription rates.

### Boston Red Sox Powerful But May Not Win Pennant

SARASOTA, Fla., April 8—(A)—Boston Red Sox have the most powerful team in the American League. They have a highly skillful manager in Joe McCarthy. They may even possess the strongest pitching. But they probably won't win the pennant.

The reason? A thinness in reserves and a lack of adequate relief pitching. Then, too, they can't seem to get away to a decent start and they don't win enough games away from home.

"If we had a relief pitcher like the Yankees' Joe Page, we would have won the pennant by 10 games," said Ted Williams, the team's top slugger.

Boston had the same team last year and in 1948. Each time the favored Red Sox were nosed out on the final day.

It will be different this year—McCarthy hopes. In a determined effort to strengthen his pitching, Marv Joe brought 20 hurlers to camp. He thinks he has come up with a couple of promising relievers in Charlie Schanz, a 22-game winner at Seattle last year, and Gordon Mueller, who had a 10-4 record at Louisville.

McCarthy is not worried about starting pitchers. He has Mel Parnell, his 25-game winning leftwinger, and Ellis Kinder, his 23-game winning righthander as his nucleus. He has a pair of classy kids in Chuck Stobbs and Maurice McDermott, and also Joe Dobson, Walter Masterson and Dave Fer-

Parnell has looked great. Kinder terrible. The latter cracked a rib in early practice and is not yet in shape. Besides, he's 35. Stobbs, 11-6 last year, is just getting over a sore arm.
