**Campbell-Frost Wedding**

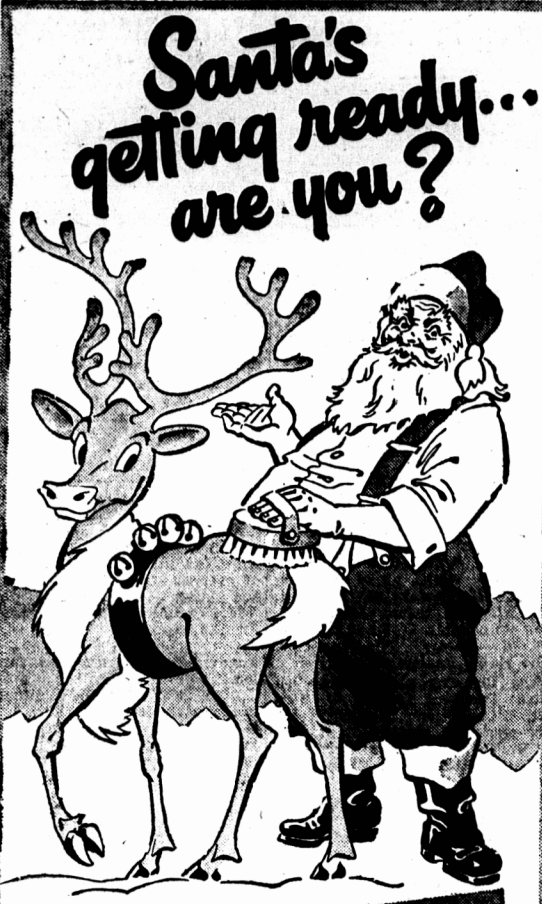

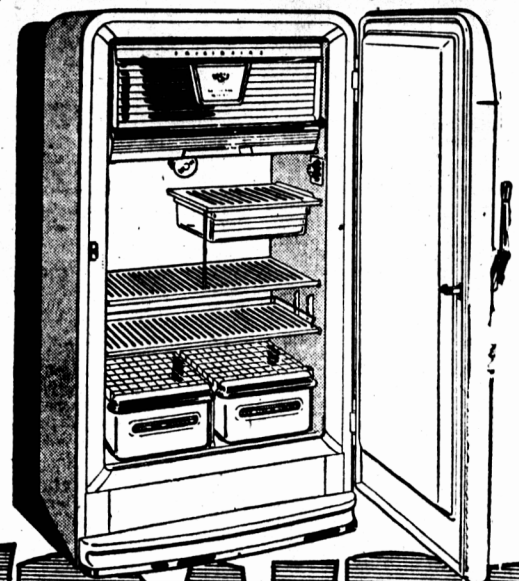

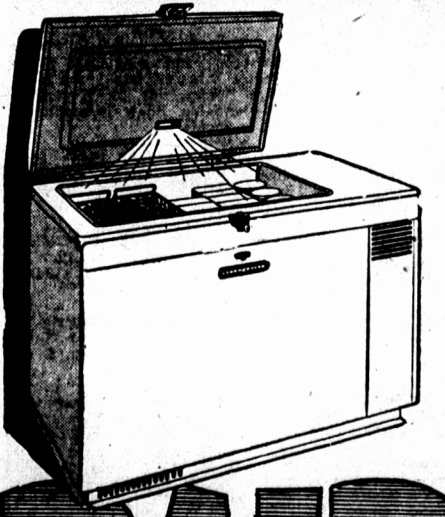
