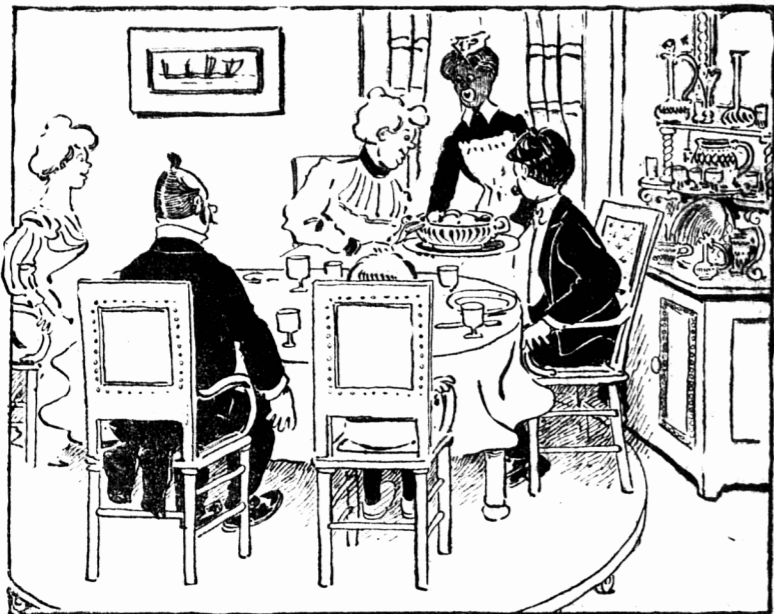
Dear Tommy: After Sister Maudie got married she went to live in a flat where the rooms are very small.



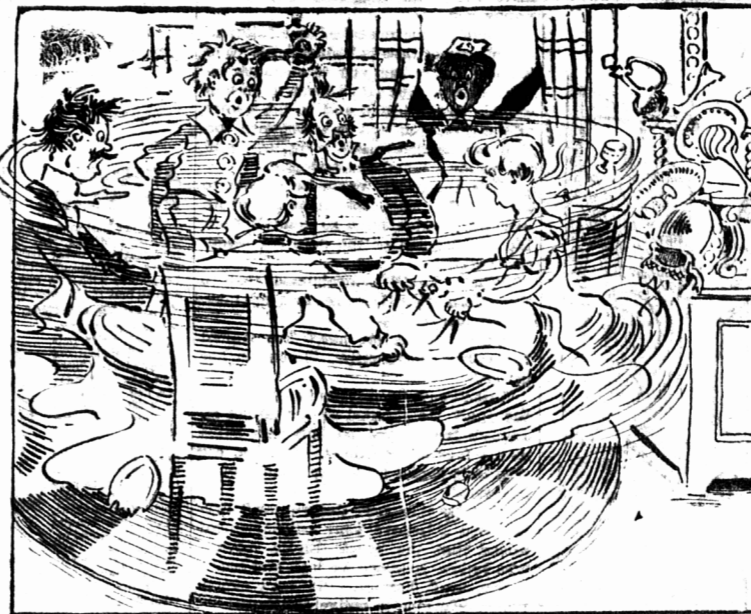
The maid couldn't get around to serve the guests when the table was extended, so I invented a revolving table.
