Ottawa gradually gave the provinces with the province in wartime tax rental rates and in post-war agreements, the provinces got increased concessions. The central administration argued that it also faced increasing responsibilities for a growing Canadian population—in defence, social welfare payments such as pensions, financing of the public debt and costs of an expanding civil service.

CONCERN AT OTTAWA. Federal administrators declared the granting of increased tax concessions to the provinces would retroactively reduce federal fiscal control over the economy. There would be less room for manoeuvring to reduce or increase taxes to limit recession or inflation.
