offering accredited courses in the applicants field of study.

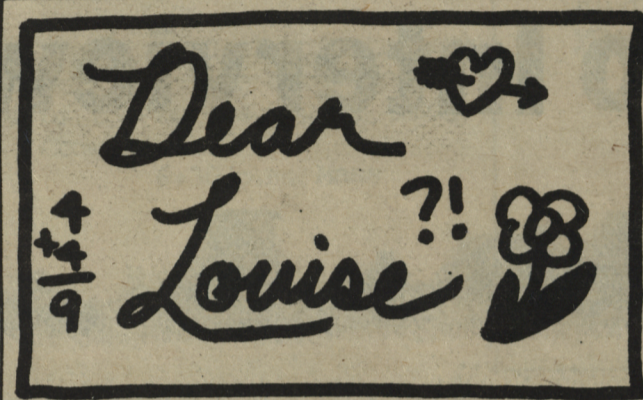
