

Pustico Man Has Sentence Suspended For Two Years

Blair Bernard Gallant, Ruston, was given a two-year suspended sentence by Magistrate J.B. Johnson in Queens County yesterday's court verdict in a case involving his possession of stolen goods valued at over \$50. Evidence for the Crown and the defence was completed for the case of Frederick Scott Coffin, Parkeville, pleading not guilty to a charge of impaired driving. The case was remanded to Aug. 27 for judgment.

HALIFAX (CP) — "The weather office says an area of showers will move northeastward off the Atlantic coast of Nova Scotia today threatening the eastern shore and Cape Breton regions with showers. Another area of showers will move into north-western New Brunswick in the afternoon and spread over most of that province by late evening.

Regional forecasts: Halifax and vicinity, South Shore, Eastern Shore, Cape Breton: Mainly cloudy; little change in temperature; light winds. Low - high at Halifax 60 and 73, Yarmouth 55 and 65, Goshen 58 and 70, Sydney 62 and 70.

Novia Scotia, Prince Edward Island, southern half of eastern N.B. Counties: Cloudy with a few sunny periods in the afternoon; little change in temperature; light winds. Low - high at Kentville and New Glasgow and Moncton 58 and 73, Charlottetown 60 and 75.

Upper St. John River Valley, Bay of Chaleur: Cloudy with showers and a chance of thunderstorms beginning in the afternoon; little change in temperature; light winds becoming south 15 in afternoon. Low-high at Edmundston and Campbellton 55 and 72.

Bay of Fundy: Light winds increasing to south 15 by evening; cloudy with rain and frequent fog patches; visibility one to three miles frequently near zero in fog but occasionally six miles in afternoon; temperature in the mid 50's. High tide today at Charlottetown at 8:32 a.m. and 10:18 p.m. At Ruston at 4:01 a.m. and 6:11 p.m. Summerside tide eighteen minutes later than Charlottetown. Sun rises today at 5:30 and sets at 6:50.

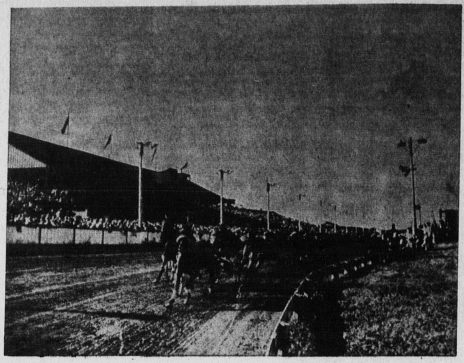
