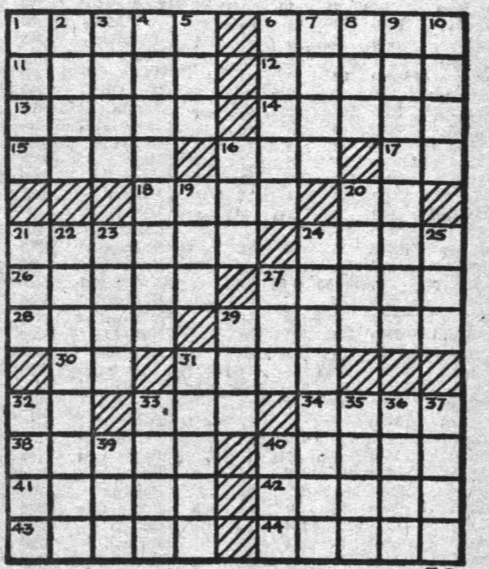
UK Suez Rebels Back In Party

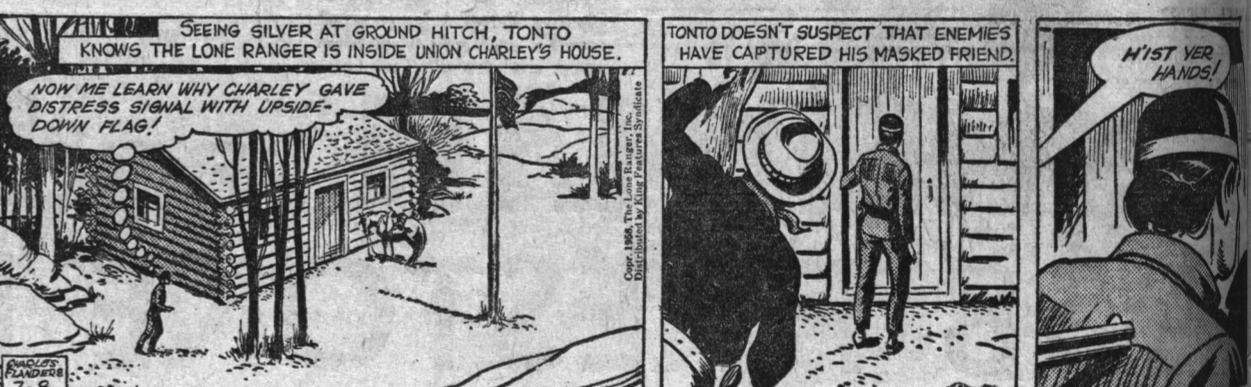

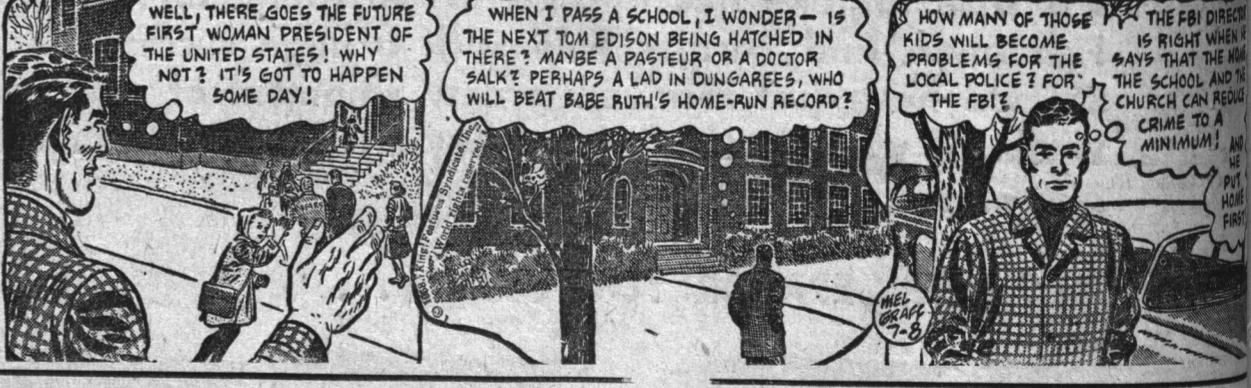
