Beautiful Barbados Imports Millionaires - Exports Molasses

For most of us the word Barbados conjures up dreams of a vacation among tropical palms waved by the warm Trade Winds. But that's not the reaction of Mr. G. H. King, a born and bred Barbadian, for Mr. King, as Secretary of the Barbados Fancy Molasses Company Limited, sees beyond the palm trees and the sunny beaches to the thousands of acres of sugar cane from which comes the bulk of Canada's and America's golden table molasses.

Although many folks don't realize it, the island of Barbados, said Mr. King in an interview recently, is one of the most highly agriculturally developed lands in the Western Hemisphere. Of its total land area of 106,470 acres, almost 90% - 94,346 acres is devoted to crops or pasture. And sugar cane accounts for almost 80% of that figure.

Apart from the granulated sugar, the major part of this tremendous annual sugar crop goes into the making of molasses - particularly of the Fancy Table variety which is sold almost all over the world, and is recognized as the premier product of its type.

Much of the credit for this deserved renown must go to the Company of which Mr. King is Secretary, for it comprises the major exporters of this delicious commodity, banded together to ensure consistent quality and improved distribution. And it is in the field of distribution that the most outstanding advance has been made in the molasses industry.

For many years, Mr. King explained, the traditional method of marketing molasses was via shipping in wooden puncheons and barrels. As these became more expensive to produce, and because of their bulk in storage on ships, it was decided to try shipping by tankers. This was an immediate success, and this year a fleet of specially designed ocean-going tankers will transport the major part of the mol-

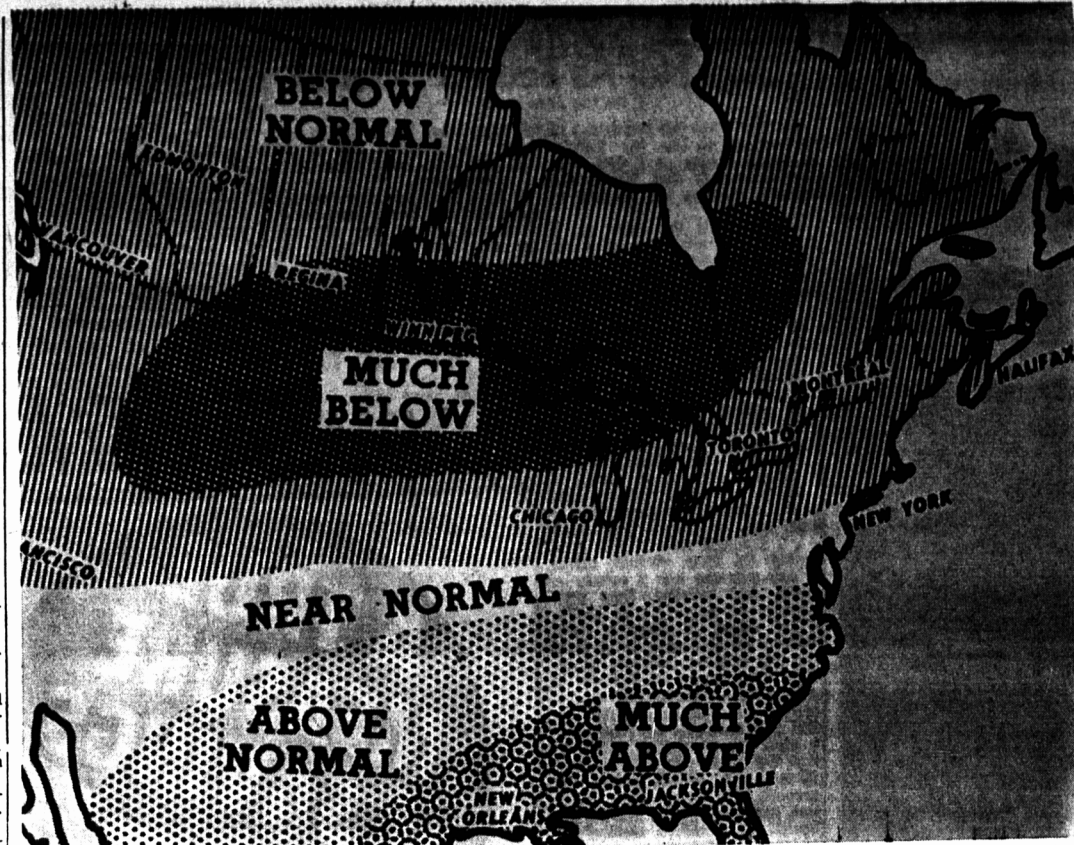
