This deal occurred at match-point duplicate, and at most of the tables East-West bought the contract as spades, invariably making at least 11 tricks.

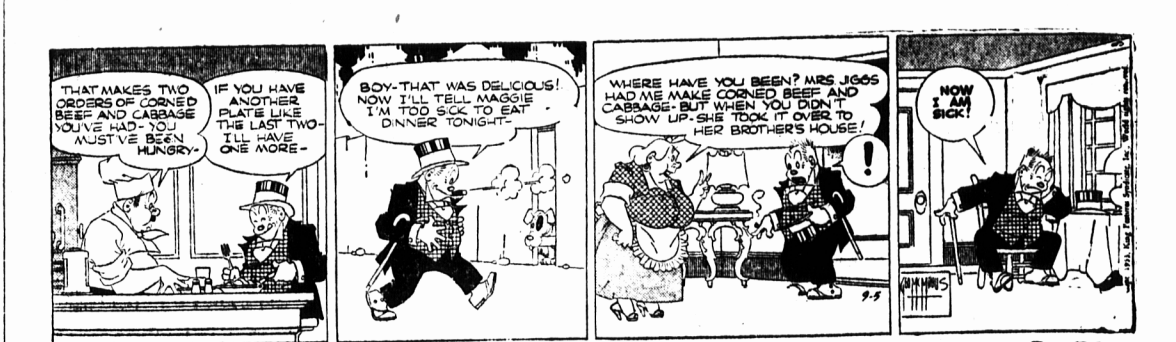

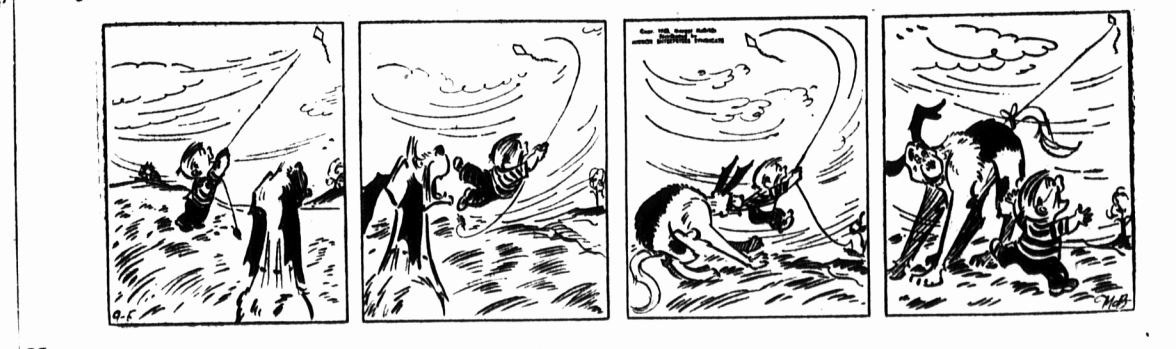

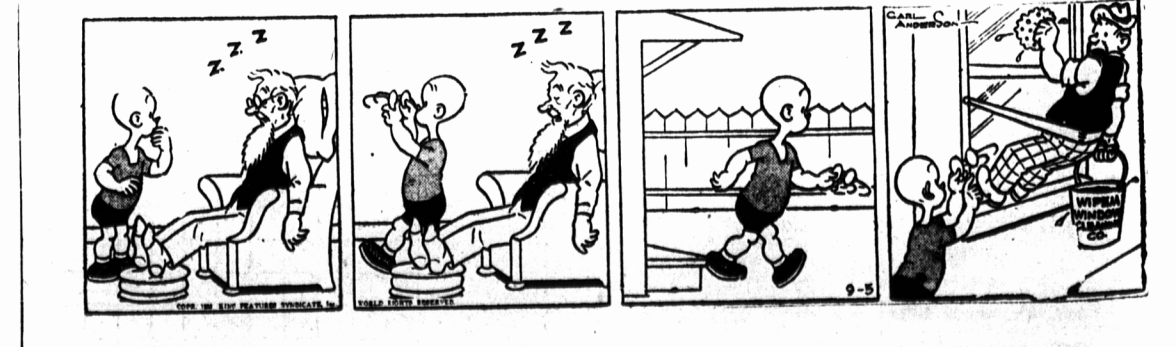
