STEEL PRICES ARE REVISED

NEW YORK (AP) - The Bethlehem Steel Corp. announced Thursday increased prices on some steel products and lower prices on others.

Increases of \$2 a ton will apply to shipments of special quality carbon bars and billets.

Decreases of \$2 a ton will apply to shipments of standard quality carbon bars and billets.

The price changes appeared to affect at least 10 per cent of industry steel shipments. Carbon shell steel billets, one of the products reduced in price, are used to make ammunition casings.

The steel products increased in price are used mainly for nuts, bolts, airplane landing gears and various structural parts of machinery.

JET FIGHTERS GROUNDED

TOKYO (Reuters) - The Japanese air self-defence force grounded more than 400 American-designed jet fighters for inspection after a crash Thursday brought the total lost this year to six. Only 28 fighters on emergency standby are excluded from the inspection. Thursday's crash involved a Japanese F-95F.
