MOUTH BREATHING CAUSES INFLAMMATION OF GUMS

Mouth breathing in boys and girls can lead to chronic inflammation of the gums.

The American Dental Association by Dr. Maury Massler and Jack D. Zwemer of the University of Illinois College of Dentistry, Chicago, and Dr. Ronald D. Emslie of London. The habit of mouth breathing, if unchecked, may result in loss of teeth in young adults.

What can be done for mouth breathers? They take moisture from air entering the lungs instead of the lining of which warms, moistens and filters air before it enters the lungs.

Another point of which parents should take note is that mouth breathing may continue after nasal obstruction has been removed. We mentioned recently that when adenoids and large tonsils are left in the mouth too long, the child develops a vacant expression.

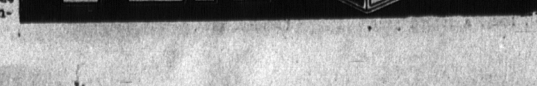
