MONTREAL, Dec. 23 - (CP) - The United States dollar Saturday closed at 2 5/16 per cent premium to the Canadian dollar, down 1/32 from Friday's close. That is, it took \$1.02 5/16 Canadian to buy \$1 American. The pound sterling was \$2.85 5/16, down 1/4 from Friday.
