

Plastic Bag Kills Baby Girl

O'LEARY — A 15-month old baby girl died Saturday evening at Milo from suffocation by a plastic bag.

The child, Darlene Rose, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Buddy Delaney, Milo, had been put to bed at 7:30. At some time between that time and 8:00, she apparently got up and pulled the plastic laundry bag down from a dresser, with suffocation resulting.

Her mother discovered her on the floor of the room at 9 p.m. Dr. Cyril Budden, O'Leary, was called to the scene, and pronounced the baby dead.

The remains were forwarded from the Ferguson Funeral Home Saturday afternoon to the home of her grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Cecil Gray, of Milo, where services will be held this afternoon at 2:00.

Interment will be in Brae United Church cemetery.

Mother Sees Son Killed

MONTREAL (CP) — A horrified mother watched helplessly Saturday as two men—killed her 21-year-old son on the sidewalk in front of their Craig Street east home in east-end Montreal.

Police said that Jean Chretien was sitting on his doorstep when two men he did not know walked by and started an argument.

The boy's mother watched from a balcony as her first son walked towards the men and was cut down by a revolver.

Police said they have a good description of the pair but no arrests have yet been made.

Yank Soldiers Attacked By North Koreans

SEOUL, Korea (AP)—Thirty-five American soldiers were under attack for about two hours today inside the demilitarized zone by a patrol of North Korean raiders who launched a heavy assault with hand grenades.

Front line officers said the attack was the longest in the eight days of fresh action along the Korean front, where an uneasy truce has existed for 19 months.

Couple Killed During Parade

RIVERS, Man. (CP)—Robert Hills, 84, and his 60-year-old wife were fatally injured as they were taking part in an old-timers parade marking the golden jubilee of this town 23 miles northwest of Brandon.

Dressed as a bride and groom, the couple were riding in a horse-drawn buggy when the horse bolted, throwing them out of the carriage. Mrs. Hills died in hospital Saturday and her husband died early Sunday.

Underworld Figure Spills Data to FBI

WASHINGTON (AP)—Somehow a secret source, FBI agents are guarding an underworld figure who has given the justice department the most detailed information it has ever had on an organization reputed to dominate much of the crime in the United States.

The informant is Joseph Valachi, 60. The organization he has described is the Cosa Nostra, sometimes called the syndicate. And what he has spilled is described by a justice department spokesman as "an extraordinarily important intelligence breakthrough" in the fight against crime.

Valachi's whereabouts are a closely guarded secret and will remain so, the justice department says. But he is to appear before the Senate subcommittee on Wednesday in connection with an arrangement he made in Chicago in 1957 to help the FBI investigate the international narcotics traffic.

SITTING ON STORY

The justice department has been sitting on the story for more than a year, but confirmed the essentials after a copyrighted account appeared in the Washington Sunday Star.

Once source said it is the first time anyone has talked to basically about the Cosa Nostra—literally meaning our things—and the network of mob that dominates in more than a dozen U.S. cities.

Among other things, Valachi has outlined the structure of the Cosa Nostra's disciplined, terror-ridden organization and put his finger on some top racketeers already under investigation.

He has provided also an inside view of what happened at the crime convention at Appalachee, N.Y. on Nov. 14, 1957. And he has named Vito Genovese, 60-year-old Italian-born narcotics boss, as top man.

Buddhist Monk Becomes Torch

SAIGON, South Viet Nam—A Buddhist monk soaked himself in gasoline and burned himself to death Sunday in Phan Thien, South Viet Nam.

It was the second public suicide by a monk to call attention to the Buddhist campaign against the Roman Catholic government of President Ngo Dinh Diem.

WATER SKIS WEDDING HELD

CINCINNATI, Ohio (AP) — What may have been the world's first wedding on water skis took place Sunday at the Coney Island amusement park's Lake Como.

Treaty Signing Set For Today

MOSCOW (AP)—With the stage set for the signing today of a nuclear test ban treaty, U.S. and British delegates met Sunday in co-ordinate strategy.

The treaty, the first important East-West agreement in recent years of the cold war, will be signed with much of Europe watching on television. Khrushchev delayed a Black Sea vacation to be present at the historic ceremony.

State Secretary Rusk of the U.S. and British Foreign Secretary Lord Home held a final conference with key advisers before the treaty is signed.

Dutch Swimmer Wins Que. Race

Henry Ford Announces Wife Par After 23 Years

The couple was married July 11, 1940.

Ford, a Protestant, was converted to the wife's Roman Catholic faith at the time of his marriage by Bishop Fulton J. Sheen.

He has three children: Charles, 19, of Detroit, Mich.; two other children, Anne, 13, and Edsel, 14.

Ford served in the U.S. Navy until his father, Edsel, died, when he was called back to become president of Ford shortly after his 30th birthday. Last year, he earned \$50,000 in salary.

A rift between the Fords had been rumoured for some time. The separation marked the first marital break in the history of the family, dating back to the turn of the century.

Society sources said Mrs. Ford probably would make her home now at the Ford Southampton home. They said Ford is expected to live in New York and international society circles.

PREMIERS MEET TODAY

Smallwood Voices Plea For Informal Conference

HALIFAX (CP)—Premier Joseph Smallwood of Newfoundland, in a small speech in St. John's Sunday, said this week's meeting of Canadian premiers must be kept "simple, unceremonious and informal" if it is to be of value.

Mr. Smallwood, the only premier who came to the two-day talks without assistants, said in an interview.

"I've come completely alone, absolutely alone. My feeling is that the 10 premiers should be completely alone and be completely unattached and should be able to talk frankly with their hair down, man to man, without any of the liturgy or the ritual or the protocol usually attached to conferences."

"I would not say we have achieved that ideal up to now. Premiers do bring along other ministers. I have never done so. I don't intend to do so."

The January Labour premier was among the first to arrive for the talks which open today in the Nova Scotia legislative building.

Uneasy Britain Wondering Is Ward Ghost To Return

LONDON (CP)—The suicide of Dr. Stephen Ward has left an uneasy Britain wondering whether the ghost of the scandal past will rise to haunt more figures in British high society.

Letters he left behind before taking a fatal dose of sleeping pills last Wednesday hinted at new embarrasments for those who travelled in the same circles which open today in the city ostrog, who died Saturday after three days in coma.

He never married and made three convicted vice charges. There also was a chilling reminder that Ward had talked with Lord Denning, the judge investigating security aspects of the sex scandal that rocked Britain, forced the resignation of War Minister John Profumo, and almost brought down the government.

"I have during my consultations with Lord Denning told him privately some of the more important aspects of the affair. I have named names and made disclosures which I did not want to reveal in public."

Authorities also were examining a batch of 15 letters written by Ward just before he took the drug overdose. They were to be given to the coroner who was recovering sites from the suicide notes.

One of Ward's last letters was reported addressed to Lord Denning. Others were addressed to Sir Archibald Marshall, the judge at Ward's trial, and Prosecutor Mervyn Griffith.

Meanwhile, one of the prostitutes who testified against Ward hummered up a story that she had been Lord Archibald. He denied it.

When Lord heard Vicky's description from the dock he described it as "a lause of disgusting lies from beginning to end."

One of Ward's last notes was to Vicky. He wrote: "I don't know what it was, r who it was, that made you do what you did. But if you have any decency left you should tell the truth like Roma Alexander. You owe this to me, but to everyone who may be treated like you or like me in the future."

"I LIE, YES"

Clutching the note, Vicky told The Telegraph: "I didn't want him to die. I never thought this would make him die. I lied, yes, I did."
