Favor Equalizing Freight Rates On Basic Commodities

WINDSOR, Ont., Apr. 18 - The railways generally are in favour of equalizing freight rates on many basic commodities where it will be to the general welfare of the country as a whole to take that action. J. A. Argo, assistant vice-president, Canadian National Railways said here last night in an address to the Windsor district of the Canadian Industrial Traffic League. "Such action," he said, "is bound to hurt some, possibly including the railways, while it helps others. We believe such action may very well be in the best interests of Canadian industrial development as a whole. "In so far as class rates are concerned, an equalized scale based on sound equalization principles, that is, weighing the value of tonnage moving in each territory as well as the rate level in each of those territories - a weighted average - would not seriously affect the railways unless it disrupted the economy of the country or forced traffic to move via other forms of transportation," he said.
