Produce Prices

MONTREAL, Aug. 27 —(CP)—Rising tendencies marked butter, egg and cheese prices on produce markets here last week, the Dominion Department of Agriculture reported. Potatoes, however, held unchanged.

Job price of first grade creamery butter prints was 22 1/2-23 cents a pound and of first grade solids 22-22 1/2 Western butter delivered in Montreal was unquoted. Price to creamery of Quebec No. 1 pasteurized butter delivered in Montreal for current make was 21 1/2 and the price of Quebec No. 2 pasteurized butter was 20 1/2.

Price to factory of Ontario white cheese delivered in Montreal for current make was 10 13-16-11 3-16 and colored 10 13-16-11 3-16 Quebec white was quoted at 10 3-8 and colored at 10 1-2.

Graded egg shipments in 30 cents a dozen for A-large, 28 for A-medium, 22-22 1/2 for A-pullets 21 for B-large, 15 for C. Uninspected lots sold at 1-2 cent less. Shipments of lower grades only were offered at 18-19 for Grade B and 14 for Grade C.

Potatoes: Quebec new crop No. 1 75's 60-65; Quebec new crop No. 2 75's 50-55.

MONTREAL, Aug. 27 —(CP)—Butter and top grade eggs eased a trifle in inactive trading on the Canadian commodity exchange Saturday. Cheese was unquoted.
