Nelson's Famous Signal.
At the United Services Institute, Whitehall, at which relics connected with Trafalgar and Nelson are to be exhibited, there is a time-stained document, framed, and hung on the western wall, from which it appears that the famous signal, "England expects every man to do his duty," was not wholly Nelson's, says St. James' Gazette.
Lieut. Pasco, who was responsible for the signalling on the Admiral's ship, makes the following statement: "His Lordship came to me on the poop and, after ordering certain signals to be made, about a quarter to noon, said: 'Mr. Pasco, I want to say to the fleet "England expects that every man will do his duty." He added: "You must be quick, for I have one more to add, which is for close action." I replied: "If Your Lordship will permit me to substitute "expects" for "confides" the signal will soon be completed, because the word "expects" is in the vocabulary, and "confides" must be spelled.' His Lordship replied in haste and in seeming satisfaction: "That will do, Pasco; make it directly." As the last hoist was handed down Nelson turned to Capt. Blackwood, who was standing by him with: "Now I can do no more. We must trust to the great Disposer of all events and the justice of our cause. I thank God for this opportunity of doing my duty." When Lord Nelson's message had been answered by a few ships in the van, he ordered me to make signal for close action and keep it up. Accordingly I hoisted No. 15 at the top gallant masthead, and there it remained until shot away." Such, then, is the duly sworn and attested statement of Nelson's flag lieutenant, which he gave to Col. Baylis, Q.C., who presented it to the museum.

Manufacturing France.
An agricultural exhibition which has been opened in Paris, under control of the Government, includes 6000 entries of agricultural implements and machinery. The exhibits very strikingly illustrate the progress made by French manufacturers in the last few years. At one time nearly everything came from England.
