350 Years Ago Englishmen Settled In The New World

Editor's note: Virginia will begin Monday an eight-month celebration of the 350th anniversary of the founding of the first permanent English settlement in the new world.

JAMESTOWN, Va. (AP)—On a sparkling day in May 350 years ago three English ships sailed up a river in the new world looking for a likely place to start a colony. The 105 men aboard the Susan Constant, the Godspeed and the Discovery were hardy adventurers, determined to find their fortune on an unknown continent.

On May 13, 1607, the ships arrived at a small peninsula about 50 miles inland from the mouth of the James River. This they chose as a site for their settlement, which they named after King James.

Grass Fire Burns Timber

WINDSOR, N. S. (CP)—A grass fire destroyed more than 50,000 board feet of lumber at the Minas Basin Pulp and Power Co. storage yard here Saturday.

Firemen, three of whom were slightly injured fighting the fierce, wind-aided blaze, managed to confine damage to a corner of the yard. About 1,000,000 feet of lumber is stored there. They said boys are believed to have started the grass fire and then lost control of it.

Usually you take a trick when you have a chance to win one. But many times, and for different reasons, it becomes obvious that winning a particular trick is a losing proposition. When it's at all feasible to do so, such a trick is rejected.

East applied this principle in the defense to bring about declarer's downfall. The ten of hearts was covered with dummy's jack and East allowed the jack to hold. (Had East covered with the king South would have made the contract easily, after conceding a diamond.) Declarer crossed to the ace of clubs, led the jack of diamonds,

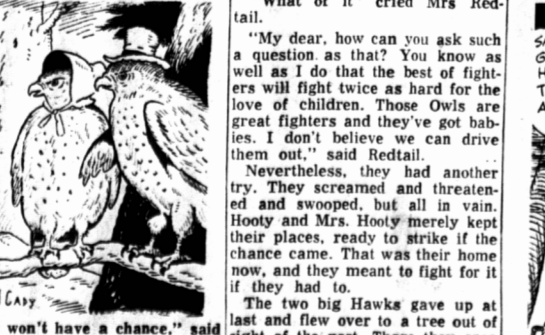
BEDTIME STORIES

U. S. Miners Mark Anniversary

PITTSBURGH (AP)—Bituminous coal miners in the United States work Monday to recall the 1893 victory in winning a shorter work week and to celebrate a new 80-cent-a-day increase in wages.

Observance of the 1893 victory is a tradition. It was in that year that the coal miners first won an eight-hour day. Michael Ratchford was president of the United Mine Workers Union then.

The wage increase was negotiated last October by the UMW and soft coal producers. It will increase average earnings of the miners to \$24.50 a day.

At the same time, most of the big soft coal producers will boost prices of the most commonly used grades of coal 25 cents a ton.

The price increase will put northern West Virginia steam slack coal at \$5.05 a ton. Steam slack coal is the type sold to utilities and is one of the industry's biggest cottage items.

Roof Abbey

LONDON (CP)—Canadian and Australian firms are helping to restore the lead roof of Westminster Abbey.

The two firms, Consolidated Mining and Smelting Company of Canada and Broken Hill, New South Wales, have contributed £30,000 towards renewal of the abbey's roofing.
