BANGOR, Sept. 15, (morning). A New Orleans letter says seventeen regiments under Gen. Washburn, as part of the great Texas expedition, were to leave the next day for the Rio Grande. Many troops are gone and more are to follow.

Philadelphia dispatch says a refugee report a broad rail at Mobile on the 4th, by women, bearing banners with "Broad as Peace" on them. Being soldiers' wives, the soldiers resisted their march. The Federals advanced to the railroad—Confederates were in position to prevent crossing. Federal casualties 31 killed, and 40 wounded. Three guns captured in the charge on the Confederate battery.

Letters from the Maine election: One hundred and eighty-seven votes, about 1/2 of the vote of the State, gave the Union candidate for Governor, rising 35,000, and Bradford, Democratic, 22,000.

BANGOR, Sept. 15, (evening). World's dispatch says that Gen. Pleasanton's reconnaissance obtained very valuable information. Longstreet unquestionably got West with one corps in success. Lee's army is now reported at 40,000, and in no condition to take the offensive.

Sumter's cavalry all run down, and horses in miserable plight. Confederates reported to have six war vessels at Richmond several iron-clad and patterned after the Merrimack.

At last accounts Gen. Blunt was at Fort Gibson, preparing to start for Fort Scott. In the recent campaign he marched 250 miles in nine days, clearing 100,000 square miles of territory from Confederates.

Refugees from Confederate, Conspiration entering Blunt's lines by hundreds. BANGOR, Sept. 16, (morning). President Lincoln by Proclamation suspends the writ of Habeas Corpus in certain cases, empowered by Act of Congress and the Constitution, deeming it required by the public safety.

An arrival at Fortress Monroe reports Fort Mifflin terribly shattered, and half of James' Island captured. Monitors lying between Sumter and Moultrie. A white flag floated over Moultrie last Saturday afternoon, having fired her last shot on Friday.

The Federals captured a steamer, Mississippi. Some Confederate passenger with escort of 40 men, and two millions of dollars in scrip. A Southern despatch mentions the upper batteries of Yorkburg are manned by negroes. Federal building works, Federal Trans-Mississippi expedition being wasted.

Steamer Mary Harlow from Charleston, B.C., on the night of the 12th, arrived at New York, does not confirm the previous report about Fort Moultrie. Gen. Gillmore actively engaged in erecting batteries at upper end of Morris Island, sustaining heavy fire from forts Johnson and Moultrie, in heavy and continued cannonading.

Sumter is entirely silenced, but garrison still there. Charleston despatch of the 14th, to Richmond says, Federal perfecting arrangements for permanent occupation of Morris Island, and connecting Fort Wagner into a powerful water battery. Federal Fort Gregg fired into boats plying in harbor.

New York Post's special correspondent says, latest from Birdsville states he had 10,000 prisoners Northward, from Cumberland Gap. Gold 132 1/2. BANGOR, Sept. 18. Times' despatch says an idea is entertained in high army quarters, that the Army of the Potomac is going west to Tennessee and Virginia, railroad to attack Birdsville—such a step ought to lead Richmond to the Confederates.

Troum's dispatch says many believe Cotton States from departed Johnston, leaving Virginia to be defended by Virginians. Herald's despatch says belief is prevalent that the enemy is about abandoning recent lines, and making stand on border of North Carolina.

Confederate's resistance in Upper quarter of South Bank of Rapidan, is stoutly resisted; position of Confederate army well developed. Guerrillas very active on Mississippi. Reported Gen. Moore's resistance on account of his disagreement with General Dahlgren. President refuses to accept.

News by this Morning's Mail. AMERICAN AFFAIRS. On the night upon which the naval expedition made its disastrous attempt to capture Fort Sumter, Gen. Gillmore had also formed a plan to make an attack on the same fortress. The detailed information of the attempt to capture the fort was made known to the rebels, and immediately an answer was returned that the navy proposed doing the same thing. The 24th Mass. and the 10th Conn. regiments, under command of the latter, were ordered to march to the fort, and were ordered to perform the honorable duty. Their instructions were, if they found the fort already taken, to retire; if not, to attack the fort with one hundred pick men, and, if successful, burn a red flag on the flagstaff. The order set out about ten o'clock, with plans well matured, a band of resolve, determined, enthusiastic men, and quietly approached the ruins. The night was propitious, and everything was moving smoothly, when a sudden report of a mile of their destination, the navy discovered already there, about to commence the assault. According to order, the army withdrew and allowed the navy to take possession in the attempt to occupy the fort.

It is probable that the white flag reported to have been flying on Fort Moultrie was the rebel flag, which is nearly three-fourths white, and nearly easily be mistaken for the Union flag. The fact of a sign of surrender. At any rate, the fort was in full operation at the last accounts, sustaining a heavy fire upon the captured batteries on Morris Island.

New York Sept. 10. Steamer Mary Sandford from Charleston, B.C., on the night of the 10th, she has despatches for Government, and a mail from the fleet.

Gen. Gillmore was actively engaged erecting batteries on upper end of Morris Island, sustaining heavy fire from forts Johnson and Moultrie. The rebels have two fifteen inch guns in Moultrie. Sumter is entirely silenced, but a garrison is there, and the rebel flag is still flying, no attempt having been made to capture the fort since the defeat of the boat expedition. The health of the fleet is good.

FORTRESS MONROE, Sept. 16.—The Richmond Dispatch contains the following:—"THE REPORTED ADVANCE OF THE ENEMY"—There was an engagement at Culpeper on Sunday last, and a skirmish on Monday, at Rapidan. The enemy are crossing the river at Kelly's Ford, and apparently contemplate an advance."

CHARLESTON, Sept. 14.—The enemy is perfecting arrangements for the permanent occupation of Morris Island, and erecting lines of telegraph along the water front, connecting battery Wagner into a powerful work, and enlarging their bomb proof, &c. They fire upon our steamers lying in the harbor from battery Garrison.

WASHINGTON, Sept. 16.—A telegram received from the Army of the Potomac, on the 15th, mentions on the Rapidan river being unguarded. About 150 prisoners have been taken by Gen. Pleasanton Sunday.

The Times despatch says Gen. Pleasanton reached the Rapidan river, at Raccoon Ford, yesterday forenoon, after considerable heavy skirmishing between Culpeper and that point. Up through a heavy force of rebel cavalry had been driven back by our forces. Fighting was going on at Raccoon Ford yesterday. The enemy were vigorously resisting all our attempts to cross. It is reported that a rebel infantry was at that point resisting our advance.

Gen. Foster telegraphs from Fortress Monroe that the main body of the rebel army is at Richmond, where Lee is headquarters now, and that there is no force of headquarters in Gen. Mead's front. Gen. Pleasanton will probably ascertain the exact position of the rebel army in a day or two.

Train cars ran through to Culpeper from Washington to-day with supplies for our troops.
