Mexico Wins Major Honors At Int. Tuna Tournament

WEDGEPORT, N. S. (CP)—Mexico won the international tuna tournament off the Nova Scotia fishing village Friday by landing two of the day's eight fish...

minutes to pull in a 300-pounder. Mexico, still hot on the heels of the Americans, brought in a beautiful 595-pounder after one of the longest battles of the day...

Mexico also won the gleaming Alton B. Sharp trophy last year by bringing to gaff the largest fish on the final day of the three-day match...

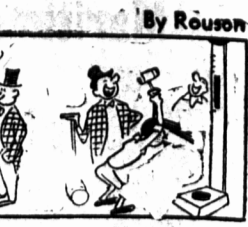
