CONTRACT BRIDGE

You are the dealer, neither side vulnerable, and have opened the bidding with one club. Partner has responded with one heart.

Q1. Three notrump. The high card power and the balanced distribution are substantially shown at one and the same time by the three notrump rebid.

Q2. Three hearts. The original evaluation of an opening bid may change drastically, depending upon the response made by partner.

Q3. One notrump. What we want to do is inform partner that the opening bid was a minimum. The rebid of one notrump is a sign off showing a balanced hand.

Q4. Four hearts. No risk should be taken that responder will pass under game. In this respect the game bid carries the same implications as in Q1.

New Wave of Attacks Reported From Cyprus

NICOSIA, Cyprus, (Reuters) — in a new wave of attacks Wednesday night, terrorists shot dead a Cypriot policeman and wounded the wife of a British serviceman.

The policeman was shot in a village 70 miles west of Nicosia. He was the fourth victim of terrorist attacks in the last two days and the 18th policeman killed since the attacks began last year.

Three other British soldiers and two Cypriots were wounded by bombs tossed in Famagusta, Larnaca and Paphos.
