

Federation Of Agriculture Offers New Service To Members

Beginning on May 1st, hundreds of Island farmers will be carrying medical and hospital bills up to five hundred dollars resulting from an accident; in the case of loss of eyes, hands or feet, \$500.00 each and in the event of accidental death \$1000.00 will go to the member's beneficiary.

With increased mechanization, farming is becoming more hazardous day by day and the Federation's efforts to provide protection for its members is welcomed by all farmers. The Nova Scotia Farmer's Federation is also considering a similar policy.

A program of this kind is only made possible by the large number of people involved and indicates once again the value of farmers working together.

On the night of April 6th, farm people all over the Province will meet in the district schoolhouses to sign the application forms and initiate the first agricultural "Group Insurance Plan" ever promoted in this province.

The details of the plan have been worked out by the Co-operative Insurance Department who will also be responsible for paying all claims.

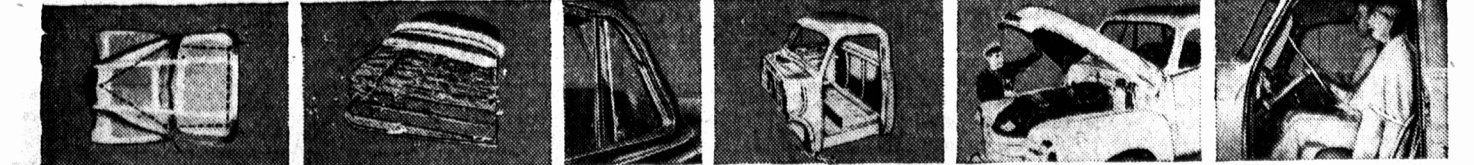
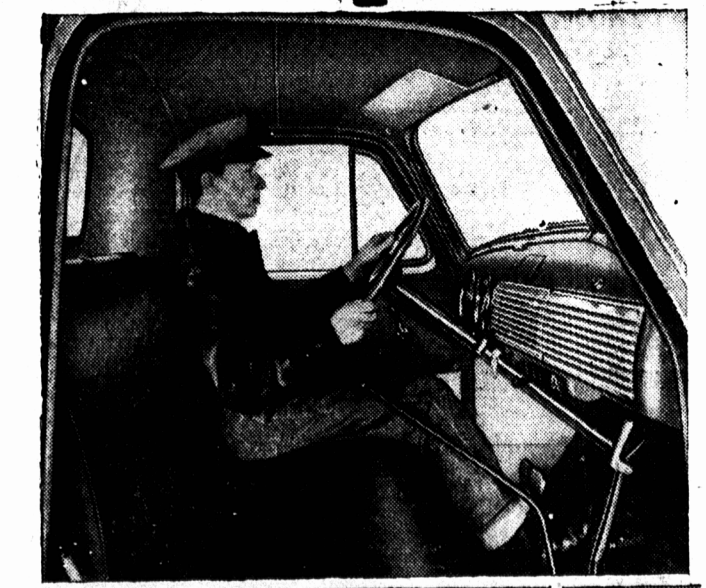
