

Alta. Firm Grabs Trade From Yanks

EDMONTON (CP) — Excelsior for packing fragile articles is a \$45,000-a-year business for a fledgling Edmonton firm.

Western Excelsior Ltd. was established two years ago by Jim Alder, A. C. Cicciarelli and H. W. Huggan and the company now serves Western Canada. Until it came into being, the work was serviced by Eastern and United States firms.

It's a key business, for excelsior is used to package millions of dollars of merchandise. It has other uses, too. Chickens, fens and other animals feed on the material a better bedding than straw.

The product comes from northern Alberta poplar. The wood is cut into thin chips and fed into a shredder. Six men run the company plant. About 200 cords of wood are consumed at the plant and about 700 pounds of excelsior produced each hour.

BALED LIKE HAY
The fluffy, white material is baled in much the same way, then shipped to manufacturers and transportation companies.

The company also produces mats for shipping animals. Another sideline is shredding old newspapers and magazines. Plans include an additional shredder this fall. The value will boost the addition of plant facilities to \$100,000.

Officials look expectantly toward new fields including excelsior brick made of excelsior and cement, and wallboard manufactured from an excelsior compound.

Nucleus For War Agency Is Planned

OTTAWA (CP) — The government is creating the nucleus of a war supplies agency to control production and distribution of war supplies in event of a national emergency, the Commonsense defence committee was told Tuesday.

Defence Production Minister Drury said staffing of the agency's national organization has already been completed and government officials "on a standby basis."

The agency would also have regional and local organizations. The setting of the regional components, also on a standby basis, has been substantially completed by drawing on the personnel of the provincial governments, business and industry, and the federal departments and agencies.

A beginning has been made on the recruiting of local and regional "agents."

Mr. Drury said planning of the war supplies agency was begun in 1962 with creation of an emergency supply planning branch in the defence production department.

WILL HAVE VOTE POWERS
The agency would be brought into existence as soon as a national emergency occurred and would have "full regulatory powers" for all aspects of control over the production, distribution and various supplies for defence and military purposes with the exception of certain aspects of agriculture and fisheries.

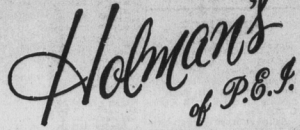
Mr. Drury also told the Commonsense defence production department, now mainly the purchasing agent for the defence department, may develop into a general procurement agency for the entire government.

Development of such an overall government purchasing agency was recommended by the Glasco royal commission on government organization.

Mr. Drury said the defence production department is conducting a study with a view to converting itself into a general procurement agency for all the goods and services needed by the government.

Mr. Drury, who is also minister of the newly-created department of industry, said that department will take over the defence production department's role of seeing that the economic health of defence industry.

It was hoped that the development of the two departments in these roles could come about during the next year.
