Would Boost Exemptions From Death Duties

OTTAWA (CP) — Exemption from death duties on estates should be increased to \$50,000, the Canadian Chamber of Commerce said Monday in a brief submitted to Finance Minister Fleming.

Proposed legislation introduced at the last session of Parliament called for a \$30,000 exemption. The chamber said the minimum should be \$50,000 and that it should be \$60,000 when the dead person is survived by a spouse.

There also should be an additional \$10,000 for each surviving child.

Other proposals made by the chamber in its brief, one of many being received by the finance minister in advance of his budget, included:

1. Pensions should not be subject to death taxes.

2. A marital exemption provision should be adopted to place persons in all provinces in the same position as those in Quebec, where persons with community property enjoyed a tax advantage.
