## N. Y. Stocks

NEW YORK (AP) - Rails, motors, and steels were buoyant Friday as the stock market advanced to its fourth straight record high. It was the market's eighth successive rise.

The market had many gains of 1 to 2 points, some higher. Losses were small.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks advanced \$1.00 at \$164.80, its highest level. Peas also were scored by the average's components. Industrials were up \$1.40 at a record high of \$222.50, rails were \$1.20, a high since 1929 of \$134.30, and utilities were up 30 cents at a high since 1931 of \$164.80.

There were 1,232 issues traded with 117 highs and 8 lows. Volume was 3,180,000 shares.

The American exchange was higher on volume of 960,000 shares against 890,000 Thursday.

Canadian issues were mixed. Canadian Pacific and Hiram Walk Distillers Seagram both added 1/4. McIntyre added 1/4.

On the American exchange Lake Shore, General Yellowknife and Royalite Oil were unchanged.
