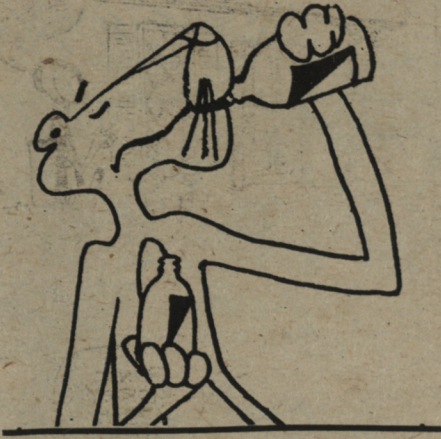

Weekend travellers using the Northumberland Ferry Service, Wood Islands to Caribou run, will notice additional crossings being made on Friday and Sunday nights. The change which became effective Monday was initiated for the fall season to accommodate the extra weekend traffic and to eliminate any uncertainty in travel plans for the travelling public.

Ferries will leave Wood Islands and Caribou daily at 7:00 am, 8:35 am, 10:10 am, 11:45 am, 1:20 pm, 2:55 pm, 4:30 pm, and 6:05 pm.

The extra crossings will see a ferry leaving Wood Islands at 7:25 pm Friday and again at 9:00 pm Sunday. The additional crossings from Caribou will be at 9:00 pm Friday and on Sunday at 7:35 pm.

The extraweekend crossings had originally been offered only in response to heavy demand. The schedule is effective until further notice.
