

### Scott Sinclair Laid to Rest

The death of Scott C. Sinclair, Montrealer, occurred in Montreal Hospital Jan. 31 at the age of 53. A former resident of Charlottetown, he was the son of the late Peter Sinclair and Mrs. Sinclair.

He was employed with the Canadian National Railways in Montreal for 25 years and was a veteran of the Second World War, serving for four years in the Royal Canadian Army Service Corps.

A member of Mountain View United Church, he took a keen interest in church activities. He was a member of the new church building committee, a member of the choir and also served in the Sunday School.

Surviving are his wife, the former Vera MacLeod of Kensington and one son, Bruce, at home, his mother in Charlotteville, three sisters, (Winnifred) Mrs. Oscar MacKay of New London, (Caroline) Mrs. Art Wright of Bouris and (Isabel) Mrs. F. E. Andrew of Vancouver, B.C.; three brothers, Donald, with the Canadian Army in Calgary, Peter with the department of fisheries in Montague and Dr. Albert M. Sinclair of Halifax. Also several nieces and nephews survive.

The funeral was held from Tuttle Brothers Funeral Home, Montreal, to Elmwood cemetery, the service being conducted by Rev. Garland C. Brooks. The church quartet sang "How Great Thou Art" and "The Lord's My Shepherd".

Graveside services were conducted by the Prince Albert Chapter, IOOF Montreal, of which the deceased was a member.

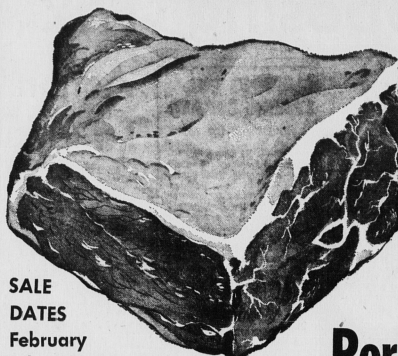
