HOW TO BUILD A SILO.

Directions Furnished by Professor King of the Wisconsin Experiment Station. It is generally conceded the form of a silo ought to be either round or as nearly square as is practicable to make it, because these forms give the greatest capacity with the least amount of silage.

The authority quoted emphasizes the importance of deep silos and of silage to insure best results. The depth should be at least 24 feet. It is important that the silo walls be rigid enough to withstand pressure without being sprung to any considerable extent.

Following is a table prepared by Professor King and incorporated in the eighth annual report of the Wisconsin experiment station. This table gives the dimensions of silos that will allow the silage to be fed down at a mean rate of about two or three inches daily, assuming 40 pounds of silage at time of filling to be fed to each cow daily.

Another mistake consists in consolidating broods by giving all the chickens to one hen when two or more hatch at the same time. Don't do it. It may seem all right, but it is all wrong.
