MONTREAL (CP)—Computer programming may become an area where blind persons can be gainfully employed, says the head of an Ontario school for the blind.
'There must be a constant search for new areas of employment,' S. E. Armstrong, superintendent of the Ontario School for the Blind in Brantford told administrators from Canadian schools for the blind at the end of a three-day conference here Thursday.

W. E. Williams, executive director of the association, said the bilingual conference, the first of its kind, was designed to invite delegates from Halifax to Vancouver in discussions about important problems of common interest.
He said, although reports from all six Canadian schools revealed that many local problems were similar, 'the solutions may not always be the same.'
