Steel Company of Canada continued its upsurge, gaining 60 cents. Algoma Steel was up 1/2 and Atlas 1/4.

Best individual gain of the day was by Ford of Canada which jumped 12 points to 175. Its U.S. counterpart dropped 1 1/2.

Papers were weak with Eddy Paper down 1/4, Moore Corp. 1/4 and Consolidated Paper 1/4. In liquors, Canada Malting gained 1/4 as did Molson's A. Distillers-Seagrams dropped one point.

On the exchange index, industrials were up .05 at 620.43 and western oils .46 to 119.52. Golds dipped 19 at 90.61 and base metals .82 at 215.86. Closing volume was 4,426,000 shares, compared with Tuesday's 3,378,000.

Falconbridge kept base metal down, dropping 1 1/2. Hudson Bay mining was down 1/2 and Vickers 1/2. International Nickel advanced 1/4.

In speculatives, Northgate fell away from its earlier gains to finish ahead one cent at \$2.60. Lake Defauld levelled off at \$5.50, up 50 cents, after climbing as high as \$6.70. Canadian Dyno was up 10 cents at \$1.51.

Western oils were strengthened by a gain of 1/2 to Pacific Petroleum, while Hudson's Bay Oil gained 1/4. Great Plains Development dropped 1/4, as did Dome.
