That Body Of Yours

PENICILLIN BEFORE REMOVAL OF TEETH, TONSILS AND ADENOIDS

Patients with rheumatism who have been advised by their physician and dentist, to have infected teeth removed may find that the rheumatic pains are more severe the day the tooth is removed and for days or even weeks afterwards.

As it has been found that most infected teeth are caused by the streptococcal organisms, a statement approved by the American Council on Rheumatic Fever of the American Heart Association recommends specific dosage for the administration of penicillin before removal of teeth, tonsils, and adenoids in rheumatic individuals or patients who were born with heart or blood vessel defects.

The smallest dose of aqueous penicillin injected into the muscles before extraction of teeth or operation on teeth, gums, tonsils, adenoids is: (a) 300,000 units 90 to 60 minutes before extraction or operation, and (b) 300,000 units of procaine penicillin in oil injected into the muscles at the same time but in a different part of the body.

Roll paste to 4-inch thickness and cut into stripes about 1/4 inches long and 1/4-inch wide. Arrange on ungreased baking sheet. Bake in hot oven, 425 degrees about 8 minutes.
