NEW YORK (AP)—The story of Wednesday's stock market was more the heavy trading. It was the fifth rally in seven sessions and carried the Dow Jones industrial average past the 60 mark for the first time since mid-May.

LEADS IN VOLUME—Steel issues depressed for months, retained their place as market leaders. Also in demand were electronics, rubber, drugs and mail-order-retail stocks.

Both the Dow Jones industrial and the Associated Press average of 60 stocks closed at their highest level since May 16.

SPERRY RAND was the most active stock, rising 3/4 at 14 on 14,000 shares.

Some rubber companies raised prices on synthetic rubber product. Goodrich was up 1/2 and U.S. Rubber 1/4.

Mail order and retail store issues responded to predictions of a record Christmas trade.

MONTREAL (CP)—Banks fell in a market of mainly mixed prices Wednesday on the Montreal and Canadian exchanges.

Bank of Nova Scotia fell 1/4 to 70 1/2. Montreal 1/4 to 64 1/2. Imperial-Commerce 1/4 to 62 1/2.

Refining oils were up. B.P. rose 1/4 to 22 1/2 and Imperial 1/4 to 43 1/2.

Western oils were mixed. Canadian Husky at 7 1/2 and Pacific Petroleum at 12 1/2.

Papers and metals were mixed. Albitol rose 1/4 to 41 1/2 and Steelco 1/4 to 17 1/2.

Among gainers, Dupont rose 1/4 to 20 1/2, International Nickel 1/4 to 69 1/2, CPR 1/4 to 23 1/2.

In losers, Jubilee rose 27 cents to 82.28.

The indices were mixed. Industrials rose 1.0 to 118.2, utilities 0.4 to 106.2.
