Suburban Ball League Underway

Sodium Fluoride Program Continuing

Approximately 160 children will have received free sodium fluoride treatment when the Public Dental Clinic in Charlottetown concludes its present program late in July. Originally given only to children of three years of age, the applications of sodium fluoride are now being given to children up to and including the age of six. Nurses at the clinic, under the supervision of Dr. B. J. O'Meara, Director of the Dental Health Division of Public Health in this Province, have been working steadily but it is understood a few more children might receive treatment before the close of the season. Dr. O'Meara stresses the fact that although the average prevention of decay by this treatment is forty percent, it can, with proper care of the teeth, be boosted almost to one hundred percent prevention. Sodium fluoride will be the subject of an address to be given by Dr. H. K. Brown, Chief of the Dental Health Division of National Health and Welfare, Ottawa, when he addresses a public meeting in Charlottetown on June 26. Dr. Brown is well known in health circles for his experiments with sodium fluoride which have been conducted in Bradford, Ontario, for the past six years.

Snead Heads First Round In U. S. Open

BIRMINGHAM, Mich., June 11 (AP)—Golfdom's mighty masters from three continents took their worst shellacking from par in modern history today as erratic Sam Snead came stumbling home with a one-over-par 71 for the first-round lead in the 51st United States open championship. The temperamental slammer from White Sulphur Springs, West Va., held the Oakland Hills ogre by the horn for 14 holes—being three under par at that point—but then he was struck with putting jitters to finish with 34-37-71. The 6,977-yard, par 35-35-70 Oakland Hills course more than measured up to the horrors which the contenders painted in their pre-tournament rounds.

Peak Passed In Recruiting Drive

Indications that the large scale recruiting drive conducted here the past few weeks is now easing off are seen. Several of the recruiting teams have been posted to Eastern Command, Halifax, or other centres. Recruiting, however, will continue for the 27th Brigade with a smaller permanent staff. Since the campaign opened May 7 the Maritimes have recruited a total of 81 officers and 2,101 other ranks. This splendid response gave the seaside provinces the lead over all other sections of Canada. Prince Edward Island contributed approximately 300 of the men. The recruiting team here was headed by Lieut.-Col. K. M. Johnston and at times sent out a mobile recruiting unit to make it easier to acquaint possible recruits with what was required of them.
