## Kelly's Cross Drilling Project Progressing

Provincial geological officer, B. Graham Rogers said yesterday that the Kelly's Cross oil drilling is down to 250 feet at Kelly's Cross, and will continue until a depth of 2,000 feet is reached. The drilling operation, which began last Thursday and has been continuing 24 hours a day, is for the purpose of finding out certain information, such as the details of the strata, temperatures, and so forth.

He added that 2,000 feet holes had previously been drilled in other parts of the island, such as Wood Islands and Cherry Valley, but that this was the first such operation to be conducted in the centre of the province. Although the Kelly's Cross drilling is "purely for scientific purposes," the information gained would be valuable in a search for oil and gas. Mr. Rogers said he would never see it at that depth.

Mr. Rogers said his department is watching with interest the drilling for oil at Pugwash.

## Call Tenders For Gov't Bldg

Architects for the project have called for tenders for the construction of the provincial government's new office building with closing date set as April 2.

Now located in about a dozen buildings scattered in Charlottetown, all provincial government offices will be housed in the new structure. The call for tenders has been issued by the project's architect, Affleck, Desbarats, Lamontagne, Leveson and Sise of Montreal.

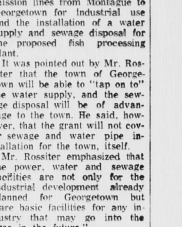

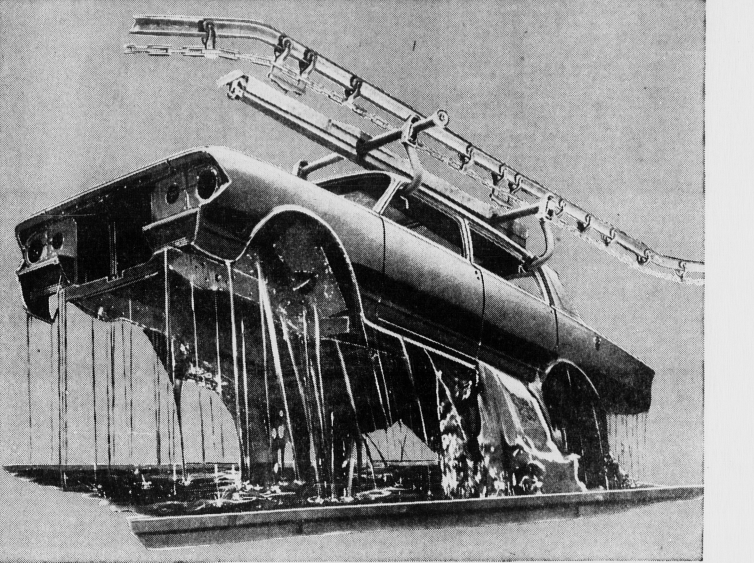

The grant will be used to construct electrical power transmission lines from Montague to Geotown for industrial use and the installation of a water supply and sewage disposal for the proposed fish processing plant.

Mr. Rosier pointed out by Mr. Rosier that the town of Geotown will be able to "tap on to" the water supply and the sewage disposal will be of advantage to the town. He said, however, that the grant will not cover sewage and water pipe installation for the town itself.

RAILWAY DELETED. Mr. Rosier said the proposed new marine railway for Geotown had been deleted from the project covered by the \$700,000 grant and will be carried on as a separate project.



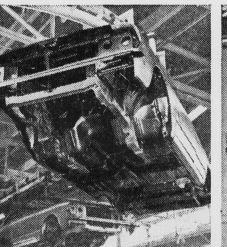

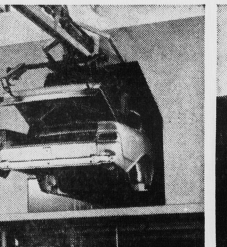

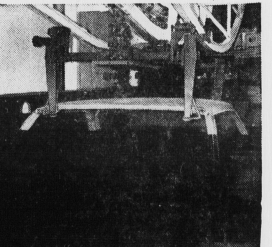

1. Galvanizing. Rustproofing begins with the steel used in the construction of a Rambler. Rust-resistant galvanized metal covers not only the rocker panels but all vulnerable areas.



2. Tunnel. The car passes through an immense tunnel. Spray jets hammer every square inch of the car's surface to remove all impurities. On its way through, the car is Deep-dipped into six tanks containing rustproofing solutions.



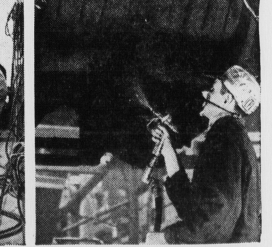
