**2,156 CAPTURED**  
HONG KONG (Reuters)—The official New China News Agency reported Wednesday that 2,156 Indian officers and men were captured in Sino-Indian border fighting after Nov. 16. A Communist Chinese cease-fire came into effect along the disputed border Nov. 22. The agency said the figure did not include 608 sick and wounded handed back to the Indian Red Cross.
