

# Argot Pointer Sets New Mark In Wins Over Cheeky Chief Saturday

Argot Pointer, a brown pacing stallion with a terrific burst of speed and loads of endurance came from behind twice Saturday night in grueling track battles with Cheeky Chief to win both heats of the Free For All and at the same time make a new record of 2:07.

The sleek little pacer driven by Harvey Cormier broke his old record of 2:09 2/5 in both heats in the thrilling battles before nearly 3,000 roaring fans at the Charlottetown track.

The Pointer paced the first mile in 2:07 4/5 and came back in the second heat to lower his newly made mark by 4/5 of a second. It was the fastest mile paced, or trotted there since Old Home Week when McKylo Cash went under the wire in 2:06 3/5.

Although there were seven horses in the race it was strictly a two-horse battle. Both races followed nearly the same pattern with Cheeky Chief leading to the stretch and the Pointer coming up on the outside to go under the wire a quarter of a length ahead.

The Pointer came on in the stretch to the quarter in 29 3/5 seconds in the first heat with Cheeky Chief on the inside and the Pointer beside him. Cheeky Chief was ahead at the half and remained there until half way down the home stretch.

The Chief was away again in the second heat and down to the half in 1:02. But again the Pointer came on in the stretch to take the top honors.

There were other great races and breath-taking drives in the ten-dash card. Little Rosalie Hooper came from sixth place in the junior free for all to take over the top spot at the half. Col. Looker was leading at the three quarter pole but the Hooper mare came back again to win in a stretch drive.

The meet was earmarked for upsets and thrills from the first event on when Charlie Willis drove Joandale to win over Milldale. A long shot, Joandale paid \$59.00 at the pari-mutuels.

Then Lela Budlong came through in the stretch to beat out the favorites. Lela went away on the pole and led the field all the way.

Lucky Number came up with another of his great stretch drives to win the fifth race, a dash for cash. Willard Kelly took Lucky Number from behind to beat out a tiring Josedale Clipper and Billy

McVey. Roach McGregor drove Silk Hal to win the last dash of the junior free for all. Silk Hal trailed Col. Looker all the way to the stretch but came on to win by half a length.

Milldale took top honors in the 2:24 trot. After losing the first heat to Joandale, Willard Kelly drove Milldale to two victories.

Alan Mac won the other dash on the card. The Sobey-driven horse went into the lead at the five-eighths pole and stayed there to win over Yankee Dale by a length and a half.

Lela Budlong and Argot Pointer were the daily double winners. They paid off to the tune of \$124.00.
