### P.E.I. Fishermen Favor Trap Limit

A questionnaire sent out by the P.E.I. Fisheries Federation to its members across the province received overwhelming support among lobster fishermen for the proposal to impose trap limits and license restrictions.

Results of the questionnaire were given the members at the annual meeting at the Charlottetown yesterday with president S.H. Burhoe presiding. They showed totals of 1,365 fishermen favoring a lobster trap limit with only 36 opposing it, while 1,263 favored a restriction on issuance of lobster fishing licenses with 115 opposing it.

Both spring and fall fishing seasons were considered with poll results for the spring season showing 1,043 favoring trap limits to 35 opposing and 965 in favor of license restrictions with 96 against the move. For the fall season there were 322 in favor of trap limit and only 1 opposing with 296 favoring license restrictions and 19 opposing.

The tremendous interest taken by the fishermen themselves in the two questions is indicated by the fact that of all the fishermen involved only two did not answer the query regarding trap limits and only 28 failed to reply on the license restriction question.

**PRESIDENT'S ADDRESS**

In his presidential address Mr. Burhoe noted past difficulties regarding the spring opening date for lobster fishing and said it was hoped some fixed date "barring unusual fishing conditions" could be established. He was of most value to fishermen by way of increased yield and saving of gear.

The president also remarked on last spring's closing date as when the federal minister announced a further extension of the season, and the creating of a new district overnight without consultation with the fishing industry in this province. He wryly noted this established some sort of record as it took the Federation three years of negotiations to obtain a separate district for the spring season in this province.

He hoped for closer future relations between the Minister and industry "and less interference by our fishery officers who have no financial involvement and a seemingly little sympathy for those who have".

Mr. Burhoe looked hopefully for improvement in formation of fishermen's organizations and their affiliation with the Federation to enable to industry to speak with one voice.

While remarking the cordial and effective relations of the Federation with the Fisheries Council in Ottawa, he thought
