The playing problem in the following deal was largely a matter of mathematical probabilities.

Hand analysis for Contract Bridge showing cards: South dealer, Neither side vulnerable. Cards: ♠ Q75, ♣ KQ97, ♦ A Q 10 7 6 2, ♥ J 8 5. Opponent cards: ♠ J 8 3, ♥ 10 4 3, ♦ K 8 4 3, ♣ A 10 9 4.

The bidding: South West North East 1 ♠ Pass 3 ♠ (1) Pass 4 ♠ Pass 6 ♠ Pass

Despite the strength of his hand, North "pressed" when he ended up by bidding the slam. His first cue bid of diamonds was decidedly questionable, since he had a six-card suit that might urgently require announcement.

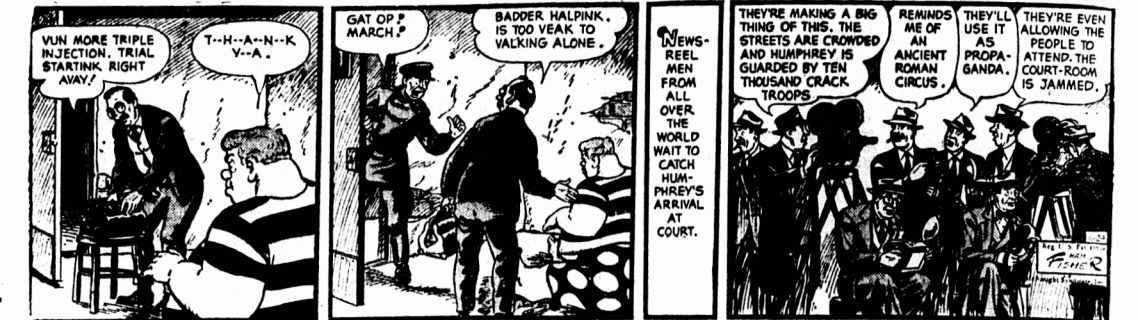
