John, Christ's "beloved disciple" who wrote the Gospels and the book of Revelation, also wrote three letters which are preserved—a general one to an "elect lady" and her children, and one to Gaius, a good Christian layman.

John's greatest message, the message "which you have heard" from the beginning, is "that we should love one another." The world's first brothers, he reminds us, came to tragedy because the jealous Cain lacked love.—1 John 3:11-12.

We must love in deed, not word. To love is to love as Jesus loved. To love is to love as God's commandments. The deceivers of the world are those who will not acknowledge the coming of Jesus Christ in the flesh." he writes.—1 John 3:11; II John 7.

To Gaius he writes commending him for his evidence of brotherly love and hospitality toward the Ephesian evangelists he had sent to Gaius' church. Others, jealous, had turned their away.—III John 1-8.

NEW YORK (AP)—The stock market settled irregularly lower Friday as trading diminished. Declines by ordinary standards, but heavy—7,700,000 shares, but it was roughly half of Thursday's 10,710,000 share total. The day began with a lower tone, the loss almost doubled, 100 to 58. Trading was active by normal standards, but much lighter than the hectic pace earlier this week. Several key issues advanced, however. Lower at 30 1/2 and 37 1/2. Dominion Textile jumped 1/4 to 17 and Canadian Breweries at 10 1/2. Trans-Canada Fund rose 1/4 to 50. Abitibi lost 1/4 to 44 1/2. American Telephone rose 1/2 to 111 1/2. American Telephone g a 1 n headed the volume parade, losing 1/4 at 111 1/2 to 100,700 shares. Second, most active was Brunswick, off 1/4 at 28 1/2 to 78,600 shares. Third was U.S. Steel, off 1/4 at 32 1/2 to 75,900 shares. Next came General Motors, off 1/4 at 50, and General Telephone and Electronics, off 1/4 at 22. Among Canadians, Aluminums was up 1/4, Dominion Textile, 1/4, and International Nickel 1/4, while Canadian Pacific fell 1/4, Hudson Bay Mining 1/4, McIntyre Percepsine 1/4, and Walker Goodfellow's lost a cent to 22 cents. On the American Stock Exchange, banks were up 0.25 at 64.24, utilities up 0.11 at 103.5, industrials off 0.8 at 310.3, combined off 0.4 at 251.3, papers off 0.4 at 49.5 and gold off 1.40 at 76.73.
