NEW YORK (AP)—The stock market stepped decisively higher Friday despite slow trading. Normally, a weakening of prices could be expected on the eve of a Labor Day weekend. This time the Associated Press average of 60 stocks advanced 60 cents to \$176.40.

Among conspicuous gainers were Union Carbide up 3 at 110 1/2, and Reynolds Metals up 10 1/2 at 240 1/2. Most key railway issues were up fractionally as were the steels. Among Canadian issues, Distillers Seagram advanced 1 1/2, Hiram Walker gained 1/2, International Nickel was up 1/2 and Canadian Pacific moved ahead 1/2. Dome Mines was unchanged. Lake Shore gained 1/2 on the American exchange and Royalite Oil was unchanged.
