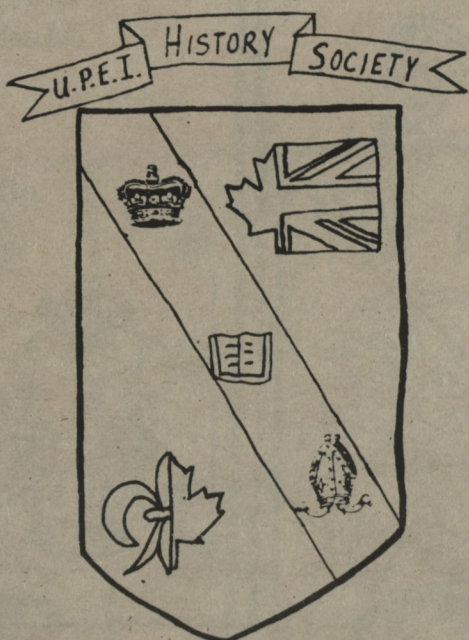
fully help each other through our academic year.
