couple of awards you might
be interested in. There

Frank Knox Memorial Fellow-
ships - The value of this
award is \$4,600 plus
tuition fees. It is
tenable only at Harvard
University, and is open
to Canadian students who
are graduating with their
first degree. The
recipients will be
required to devote the
major portion of their
time to study in one of
the Faculties of Harvard
University: Arts and
Sciences (including
engineering), Business
Administration, Design,

Divinity, Education,
Law, Public Administration,
Medicine, Dentistry, and
Public Health.
Deadline: December 1, 1981

Trinity College in the
University of Toronto
Awards for Graduate Study -
Six graduate fellowships
are awarded annually by
the college to men and
women who are pursuing
studies in the graduate
school of the University
of Toronto. The fellow-
ships provide residence
and board in either Trinity
College or St. Hilda's
College, and membership in
the Senio Common Room.
They may be held in
conjunction with cash
awards or teaching
assistanceships from
other sources.

The James C. Cumming
Fellowship is awarded
to a recent graduate in
Arts, Science, or
Divinity of any accredited
university. The Provost
Seely Fellowships are
awarded to graduates
who are not Canadian,
and are graduates of
accredited universities
outside Canada.
