

# Canada's Women Athletes Hold Amateur Spotlight

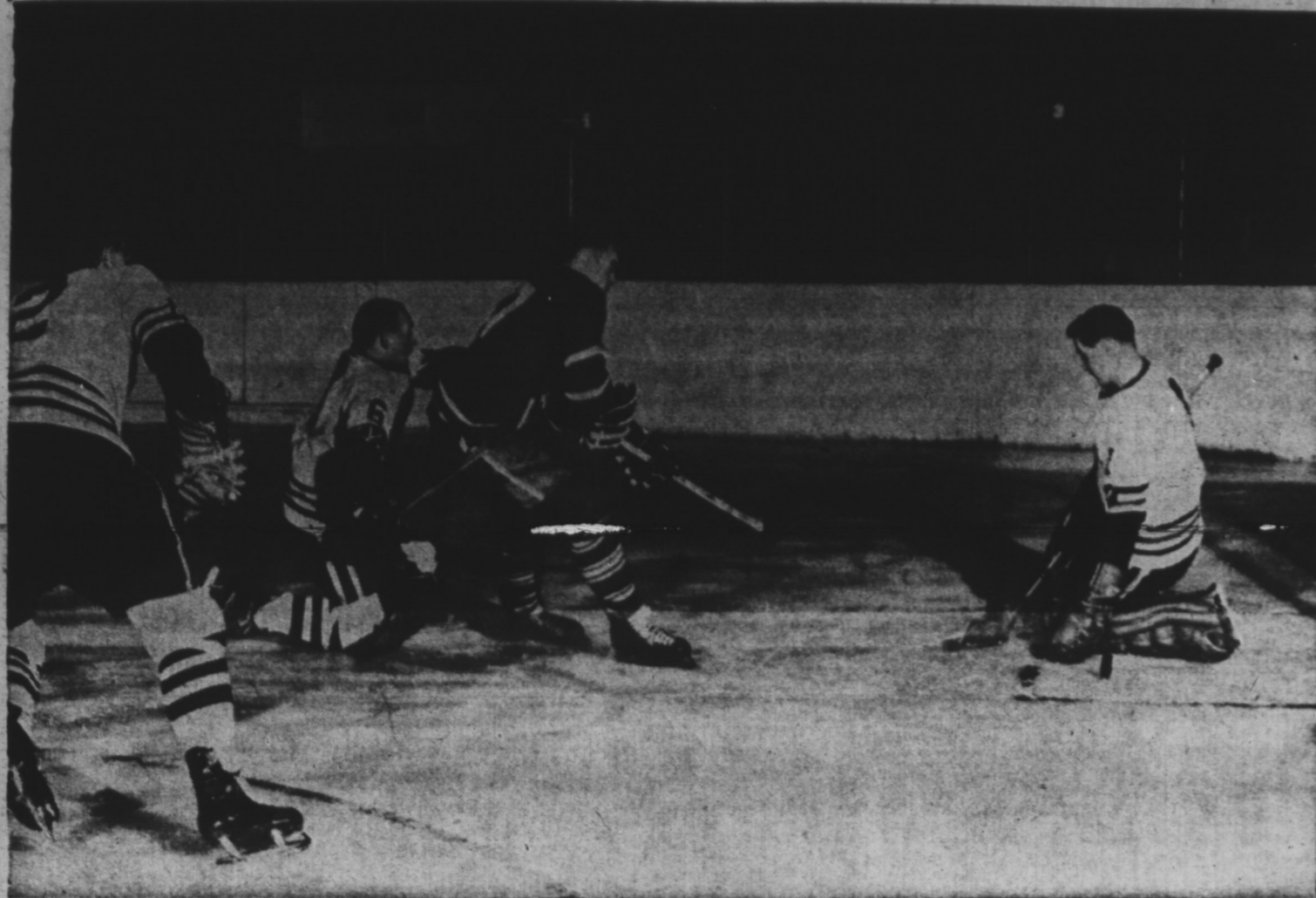

## Injury May End Rocket's Career

MONTREAL (CP) — Maurice Richard has expressed misgivings about his chances of being able to return to the National Hockey League wars this season. The Rocket Tuesday described the injury that sidelined him a month ago as "not very good."

The Montreal Canadiens veteran star suffered fracture of an ankle bone during a game in Chicago Jan. 18. Two days later, after his arrival home, the leg was put in a cast.

"During the last few days I've been bothered with a rash that developed under the cast," said Richard. "I told the doctors about it and they decided to remove the cast and take a look at the injury."

CHICAGO (AP) — Bill Veck, on behalf of a syndicate, agreed Tuesday to buy controlling interest in the Chicago White Sox American League baseball club. He has not less than 15 nor more than 45 days to complete the \$2,700,000 deal.

Veck exercised his option to buy the 54 per cent holdings of Dorothy Comiskey Rigney, who has been feuding with her brother Chuck Comiskey, for more than a year over control of the club. Veck had paid \$100 for the 60-day option to buy which he signed with Mrs. Rigney Dec. 20.
