The draft resolution was supported by Canada.

From the Queen Street entrance patrons are greeted with the sight of 175 feet of groceries and refrigeration cases. From the Richmond Street entrance patrons get a close-up view of all the refrigeration and display cases. The frozen food cases contain practically everything from frozen meats and strawberries to a complete dinner ready for serving.

The refrigerated fruit and vegetable display cases are equipped to keep the fruit and vegetables fresh and crisp while retaining their flavor and freshness.

The refrigerated dairy case contain the largest variety of cheeses anywhere in Eastern Canada. Contained in the multiple deker cases are eggs, butter, shortening, lard, milk, cream and soft drinks.

The Co-op has the exclusive franchise on Prince Edward Island for Downyflake doughnuts which are made by the doughnut machine in the store. For hungry customers who want a quick bite there is a modern snack bar.

Cam McLean, the store manager, is not stranger to business people. He has been in charge of the store for the past six and a half years and since coming to the Island has become widely known and well liked by Island people. He has spent his life in the food business, working with Loblaw's, the Red and White Chain General Foods, and operating his own stores in Ontario.

The assistant-manager is Wally Coles. Cecil Santry is head of the Fruit Department; Aeneas Curley heads the meat department and, Ivan Morrow is in charge of the floor.

The weekly payroll of permanent employees exceeds \$1,500 augmented at Christmas time by a sizeable bonus. In addition they receive holidays with pay, Blue Cross and sickness insurance and a pension scheme where the employees pay five per cent or more of their salary with the company matching these payments.

The President is quiet speaking and amiable L.C. Callbeck, J.J. MacDonald is vice president and Wilf Driscoll secretary. Other directors include Walter MacMillan, Charles Jones, Austin Kennedy, Wendall Mutton, Allison MacMillan and Major W.F. Andrew.
