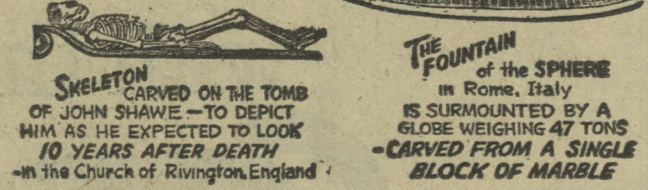

Opening lead—queen of spades. The question of when to draw trumps and when not to does not lend itself to a flat rule. In general, it may be stated that when declarer has high cards in side suits which can be lost only if they are trumped by the defenders, he proceeds with the extraction of adverse trumps as soon as it is practically possible.

Satellite Firings Planned From California Coast Base

WASHINGTON (AP)—The first of a dozen or more earth satellites will be fired from California's coast in the near future. Some will carry mice and perhaps a monkey. The satellites will be aimed at orbits to take them around the poles of the earth. The hope is to fire one a month. The advanced research projects agency of the defence department Wednesday announced details of the project, named Discoverer.

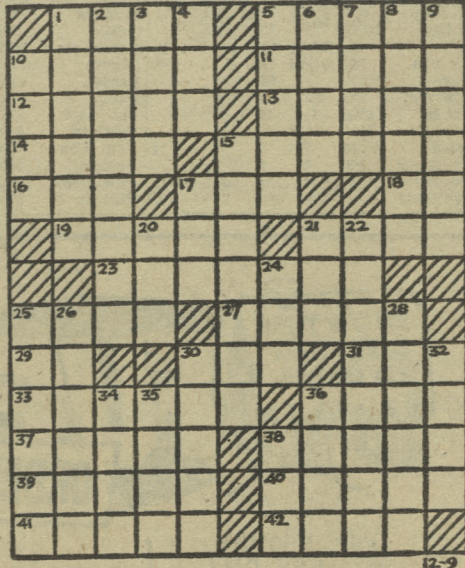
From these initial attempts it is expected that bigger efforts will evolve, using Atlas intercontinental ballistic missiles and multi-ton satellite vehicles. The U.S. Air Force will attempt to bring at least some animals back from their journeys into space. Russia's successes in putting huge satellites into orbit and recent unofficial speculation that the Soviets may have sent a rocket into outer space is spurring the new American effort.

Moscow Finds Graft Ring

MOSCOW (AP)—Investigators have discovered a ring of Moscow officials who substituted graft for examinations in the issuance of many automobile drivers licenses. The government newspaper Izvestia said numerous Muscovites undertaking required training, including a study of automobile engines, prior to obtaining licences found a shortcut by paying 500 rubles (\$125) to the chief of the official motorists school, A. N. Nebolsin.
