Maritime Talent Featured At Scottish Concert Here

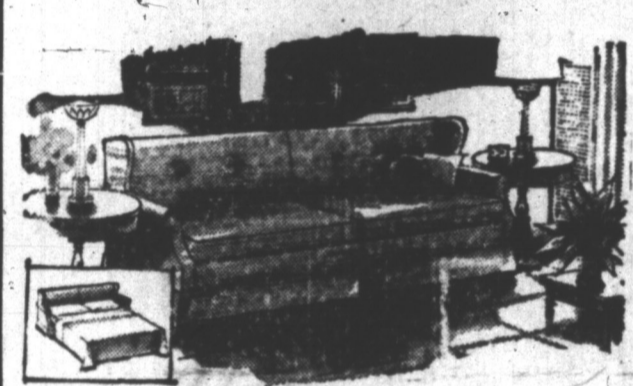

New Library Building Slated For Construction In Spring

Another big construction project here will see the start this spring of a new library for Saint Dunstan's University. Most Rev. J.A. Sullivan, rector, said yesterday.

The structure will have two storeys, measuring 160 feet long by 85 feet wide, and will cost an estimated \$400,000.

Housing Starts Show Increase

OTTAWA (CP) — Housing starts in Canadian centres of more than 5,000 population were 30.9 per cent higher in 1967 as compared to 1966, Central Mortgage and Housing Corporation reported Tuesday.

BRIEF PRESENTED — Originally, the grant was based on payments of \$1.50 per head of population of the province and divided according to the student enrollment in the university. Last summer the Canadian universities presented a brief to the government requesting a raise in the basic grant to \$2.50, or an increase of \$1. The amount granted was 50 cents. It will increase the annual federal grant to St. Dunstan's to approximately \$125,000.

Opening Slated For Souris Feb. 7

Ceremonies marking the completion of the Souris co-operative housing development have been tentatively set for Tuesday afternoon, Feb. 6.

Builders started 92,741 new units during the year, a jump of almost 24,000. All provinces showed gains with Prince Edward Island up more than 800 per cent to 483 units from 54. Housing completions declined 8.1 per cent to 83,142 units.

The year's housing starts by province, with 1966 figures bracketed: Newfoundland 426 (306), Prince Edward Island 483 (64), Nova Scotia, 1,545 (1,496), New Brunswick 1,099 (800), Quebec 26,980 (23,582), Ontario 36,374 (30,896), Manitoba 4,660 (4,232), Saskatchewan 3,263 (2,679), Alberta 10,151 (6,190), British Columbia 7,760 (6,442).

Veteran Sealer Planning Hunt

ST. JOHN'S, Nfld. (CP) — Capt. William Moss of St. John's, a veteran sealer captain, said Monday he would sail to the seal fishing grounds this spring aboard the Arctic Prowler, bought recently by North Star Shipping in Halifax and renamed the North Star.

For the last six years Capt. Moss sailed in the Arctic Sealer, owned by the Shaw Steamship Company in Halifax. He said he would take a 60-man Newfoundland crew to the ice flows in the gulf of St. Lawrence.
