## St. Dunstan's Has Record Enrollment

St. Dunstan's University officials are faced with a housing problem. For the first time in the history of the institution it has been found impossible to accommodate all the students in residence who wish to live there.

The registrar of the century-old institution, Rev. Edmund Roche, says total enrollment is expected to stand at 350, of which 59 will be girls. The total exceeds last year's by 55.

Father Roche says the extra enrollment is gradually being absorbed into accommodations in or near the city.
