10 Contenders For Middleweight Champion

NEW YORK, Jan. 13 (AP)—The New York State Athletic Commission and the National Boxing Association Monday recognized a list of 10 contenders to participate in an elimination tournament to determine an American middleweight champion.

After the tournament the survivor is to meet the European champ, determined by a bout between Randy Turpin of England and Charles Humez of France.

The 10 middleweights in the American tournament are: Carl (Bobo) Olson of Honolulu, Norman Hayes of Boston, Ernie Durando of Bayonne, N.J., Paddy Young of New York, Rocky Castellani of Luzerne, Pa., Walter Cartier of New York, Lee Sala of Dondora, Pa., Pierre Langlois of Paris, Joey Giardello of Philadelphia and Eugene Harston of New York.

The only bouts set at this time are Olson-Hayes in Boston, Feb. 7 and Castellani-Langlois in New York, Feb. 6.

Rumors Regina Interested In Pro Hockey

EDMONTON, Jan. 13 (CP)—There have been rumblings lately that Regina may be interested in entering the Professional Western Hockey League, joining Saskatoon, Calgary and Edmonton, who made their debut in the circuit last season.

The four centres made up the old Western Canada Senior Hockey League, which disbanded after the 1950-51 season. Regina now has teams in the Western Junior League and the four-team Saskatchewan Senior.

Biggest point favoring admittance of Regina is that it would help remedy the present unbalanced schedule, which sees 20-game marathons between the Prairie clubs that tend to become tiresome. On the other hand, Prairie clubs meet each of the five west coast teams only six times.

Adding coal to the fire are reports that the WHL Tacoma franchise hasn't been doing too well at the gate in the last two seasons. That could be the wedge Regina

needs, if some big money also is found.

Most of the eight WHL teams now have hook-ups with NHL clubs. Meanwhile, Doug Bentley's Saskatoon Quakers have opened up a five-point, first-place bulge over Calgary Stampeders but the cowboys have three games in hand. Vancouver Canucks under Art Chapman trail Stampeders by a single point.

Incident Ends Soccer Tour

GUATEMALA CITY, Jan. 13 (AP)—A "scandalous incident" elsewhere it would be called a junior-sized riot—apparently has terminated the five-game visit to Guatemala by the Argentine soccer team "Boga Junior."

Managers of the Argentine team, which has played three games here and was scheduled for two more, Monday said the team "will be unable to complete the schedule as a result of the scandalous incident which occurred during yesterday's game."

On the other side, it was reported that the Guatemala Sports Confederation was planning legal claims against the Boca Junior team for

damages done to the Stadium and the injury to the referee Sunday.

The "incident" took place when the Argentine players, taking exception to decisions by Guatemalan referee Romulo Estrada, began to push Estrada around and one player kicked him violently.

Spectators threw sticks ripped from the seats, stones, and dirt at the Argentine players, and broke windows in the Stadium building. Estrada was removed to a hospital with a broken leg. Police sprayed water on the crowd, which over-ran the field.

Better Fish With Wonder Drug

OTTAWA, Jan. 13 (CP)—Aureomycin—the "wonder drug" used against a wide variety of bacterial diseases—also produces larger and healthier fish, the Resources Department reported Monday.

Small amounts added to the fishes' regular food produced bigger and better brook trout in a 13-week experiment conducted at the fish hatcheries at Jasper National Park.
