NOTICE

REGULATIONS TOWN PLANNING ACT 1946 CHARLOTTETOWN ROYALTIES

1.-No person shall sell or purchase any building lot (a) having a frontage on the street or road of less than seventy-five feet; (b) having an area of less than seventy-five hundred square feet; (c) in any Zone which is not served by a water supply from a municipality, having an area of less than twelve thousand feet.

2.-Penalties are provided under the Act for non-observance of these regulations.

3.-Permits are required for any future building in the above mentioned area and may be obtained from this Department.

4.-No person shall commence the digging or construction of any well without first obtaining a permit therefor from the Minister.

5.-No person shall commence the construction or installation of any septic tank or other similar means of sewage disposal without first obtaining a permit therefor from the Minister.

AMENDMENT

Section 23 of the Town Planning Act is amended as follows: NO PERSON SHALL COMMENCE CONSTRUCTION OF ANY TYPE OF BUILDING WITHOUT FIRST OBTAINING A PERMIT THEREFOR FROM THE MINISTER.
