



MODEL SEEKS DIVORCE

Mrs. Dovima Murray, once known as the world's highest paid fashion model (\$100 per hour), appears in a Los Angeles Superior court Thursday with her daughter, Allison, 7, to seek a contested divorce from Alan Murray, a U.S. immigration service investigator. Two days ago Mrs. Murray was arraigned on a fugitive warrant charging she kidnaped her daughter from her husband's New York home.

Voluntary Statement Stage Ordered In Quebec Murder

QUEBEC (CP) — Andre Lamothe, 41, Thursday was sent to voluntary statement on a charge of capital murder in the death of Alberic Bilodeau.

Bilodeau's body was one of four found recently in wooded marshland south of Quebec City by Quebec Provincial Police.

Lamothe's voluntary statement was set for Dec. 10. Voluntary statement is a stage in Quebec judicial proceedings during which a defendant may present evidence designed to prevent his case from being sent to trial.

Lamothe, a lumber merchant from Quebec City, appeared Thursday before Judge Albert Dumontier.

Two Crown witnesses testified at the preliminary inquiry. Defence Lawyer Dollard Danereau asked Judge Dumontier to allow Lamothe to see his (Lamothe's) doctor for an examination.

Mr. Danereau said: "I know my client has been examined by two doctors, but I'd like his doctor to examine him because he has pains in his legs and head."

Judge Dumontier said he had no authority to order such an examination but he advised Mr. Danereau to make the request of the provincial justice department.

Testimony was given at the inquiry by Orle Boulet and Ferdinand Quirion.

TESTIFIES AND DIES
Bilodeau is thought by authorities to have died Sept. 18, a few days after having testified before the provincial fire commission concerning a fire that destroyed a hotel he owned in St. Joseph de Beauce.

Three other persons—Quirion, Boulet and Jean-Jacques Gagnon—have been held criminally responsible by a coroner's jury in the death of Bilodeau.

Only Lamothe has been charged in the case. At Thursday's hearing, Quirion, 43, of Quebec City, testified for almost one hour after asking the protection of the court.

He also asked permission to sit while giving evidence. "because I am pretty weak."

He said he never participated in the slaying of Bilodeau.

Boulet, 52, a laborer, said in answer to questions from Crown Prosecutor Roch LeFrancois that he had accompanied Lamothe, Gagnon and Quirion to St. Henri de Levis, Que., where the group had to meet Bilodeau.

Boulet said they met Bilodeau and that the latter rode in his own car together with Gagnon, while Lamothe and Boulet followed in Lamothe's blue Cadillac.

Boulet said Quirion also followed in a car but that he had left the two others.

HEARD NOISES
Boulet said that at a certain moment, while on a dirt road, he had heard two small noises.

Boulet said Lamothe then brought his car close to Bilodeau's and that he ordered Boulet to take the wheel. Boulet moved toward the Bilodeau vehicle and saw in it a man stretched across the front seat.

Boulet told the court: "Jean-Jacques Gagnon then sat in the back seat and I took the wheel, and I followed Lamothe as far as St. Giles de Lotbiniere where the latter ordered me to bury the corpse with the shovel and caustic lime that belonged to me but which he brought in his car."

Boulet said Lamothe has loaned a pearl-handled, gold-barreled revolver to Gagnon. Gagnon later returned this revolver to Lamothe.

Boulet testified that during that evening he went with Gagnon to a point near a village in Lotbiniere County and that he set fire to Bilodeau's car.

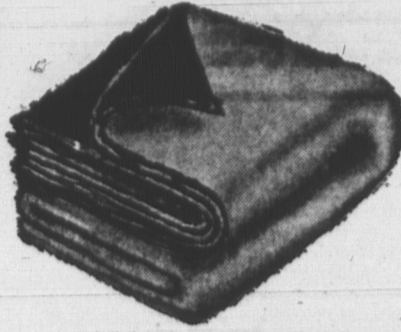

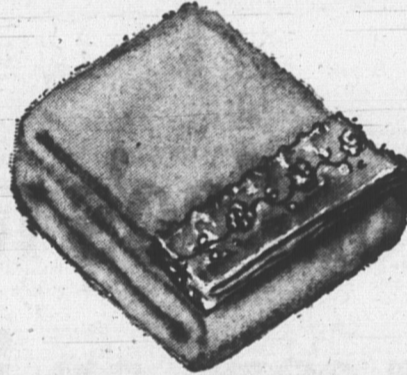

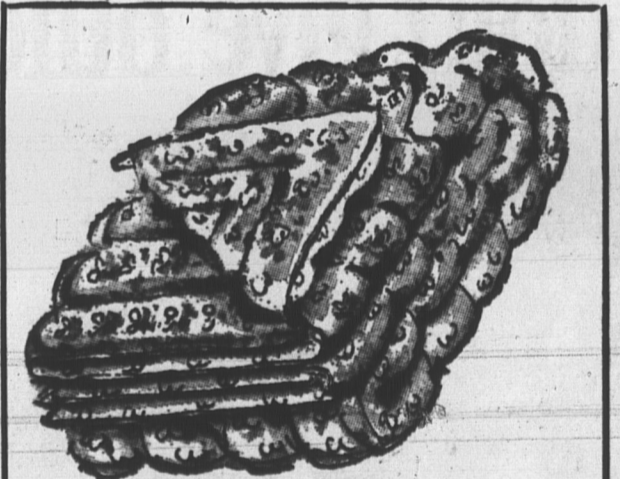
