IN MEMORIAM MAURICE GALLANT

The death occurred at his home in St. Charles on Sunday, October 12th, 1958, of Maurice Gallant in his 76th year. In his last illness Maurice was attended by his physician, Dr. MacLellan, and spiritual comfort was rendered by his pastor, Rev. Charles Gallant and by Rev. Joseph MacLeod.
